Abi calls him Kobi. It is a joy to have a calf on the farm.

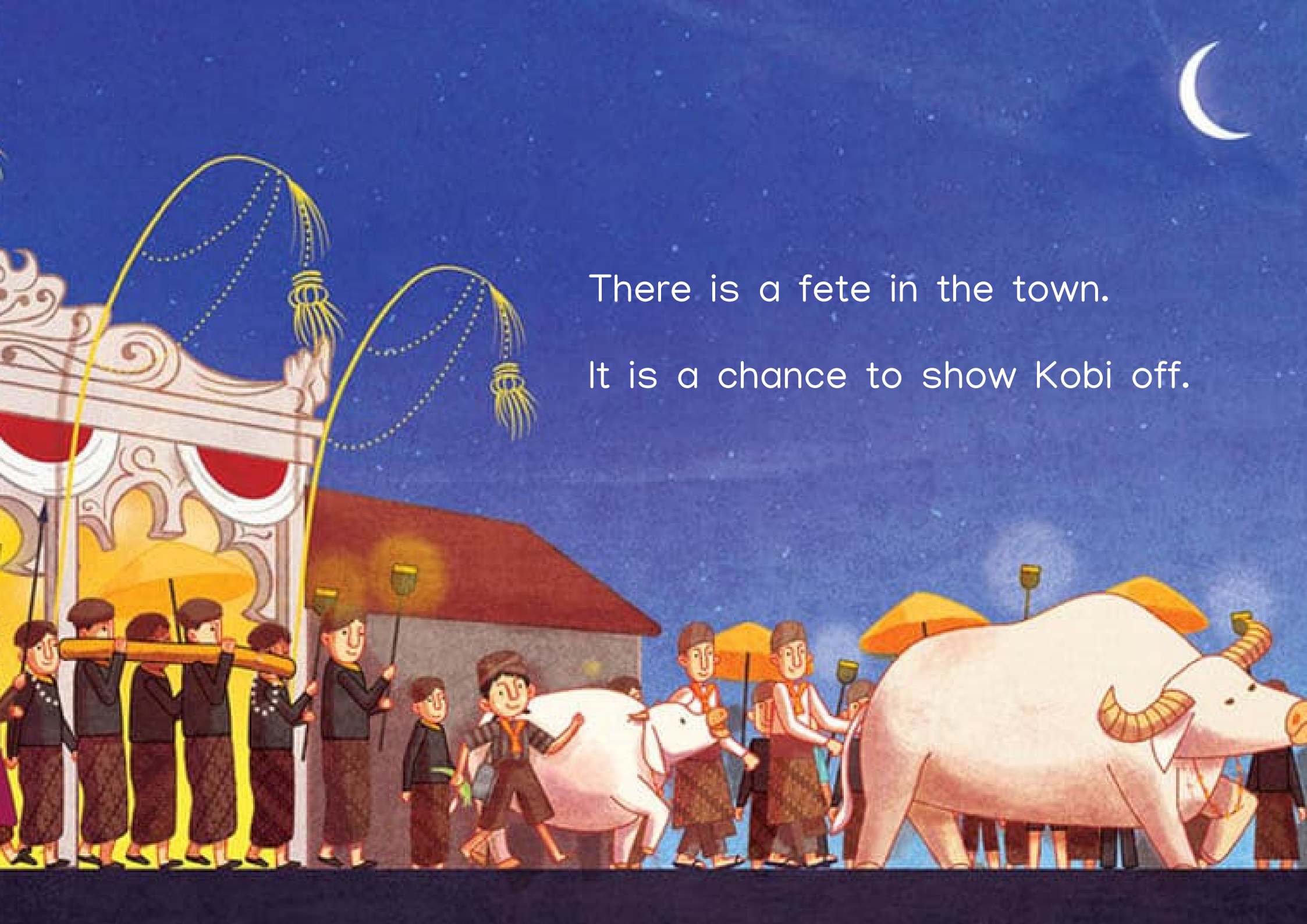


Abi needs to feed

give him the grass.

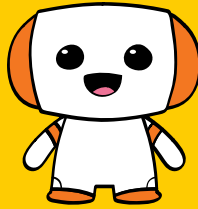
He sings to Kobi.
