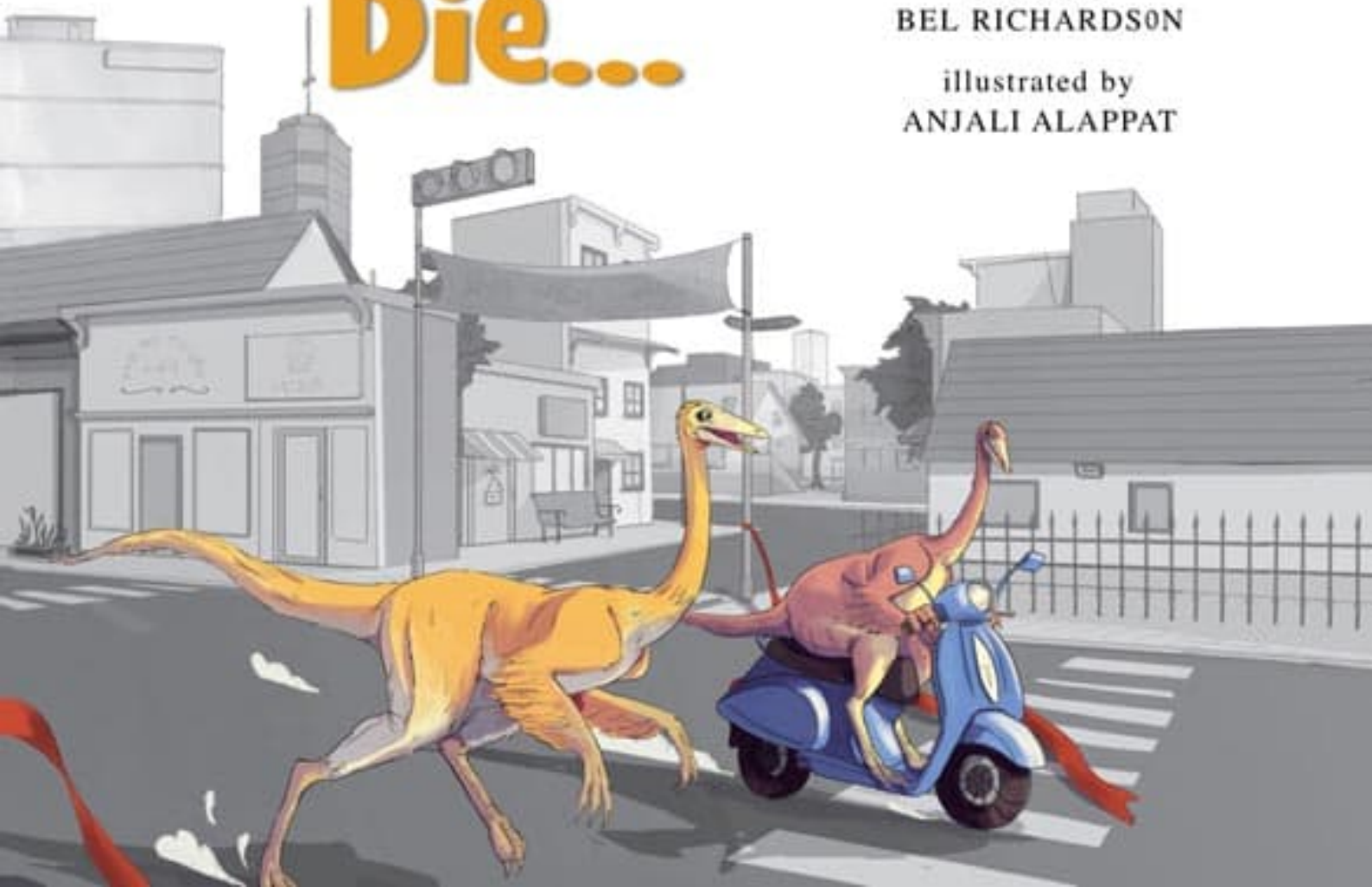

dinos in the past.



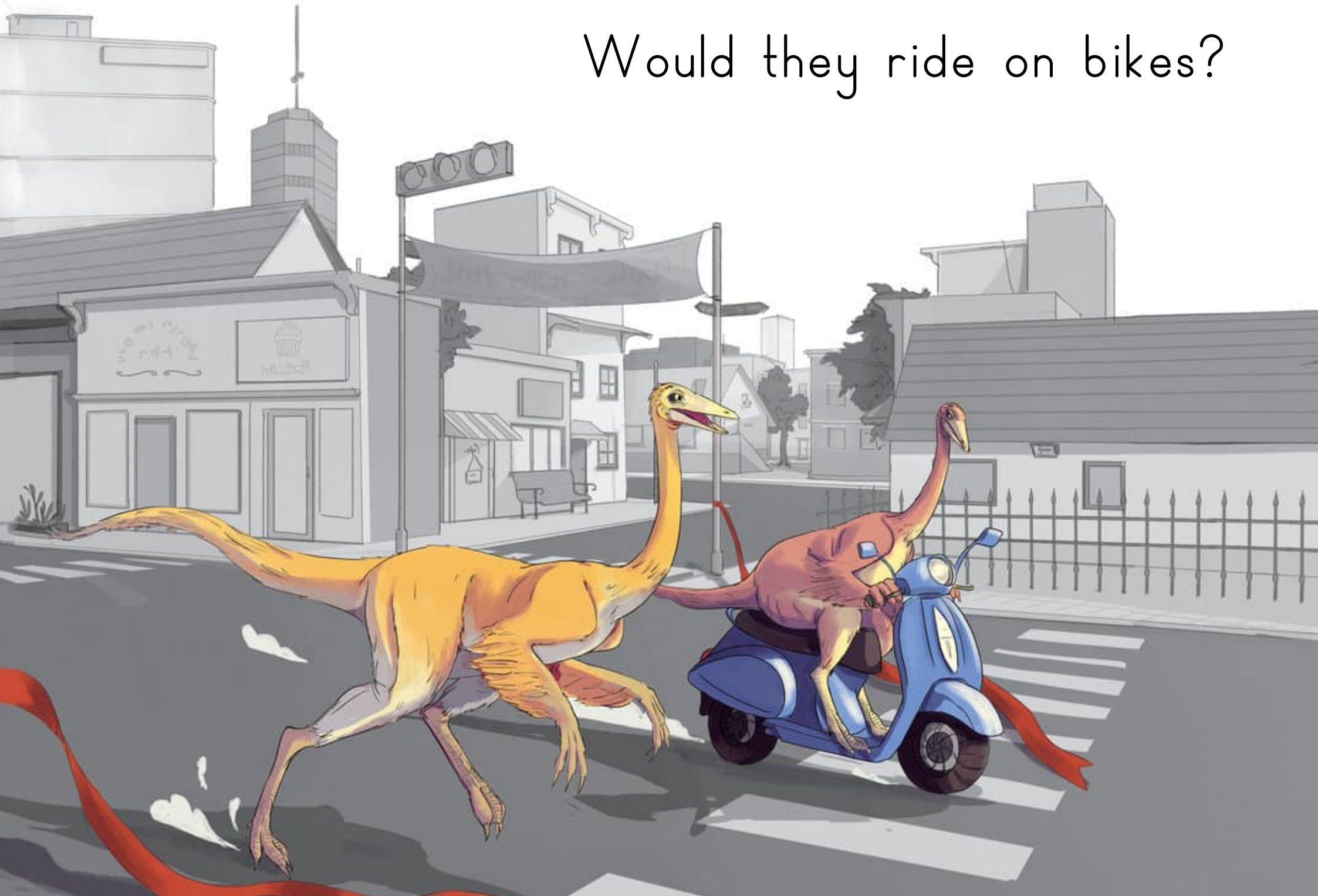
If the dinos did not die... dinos

slide.



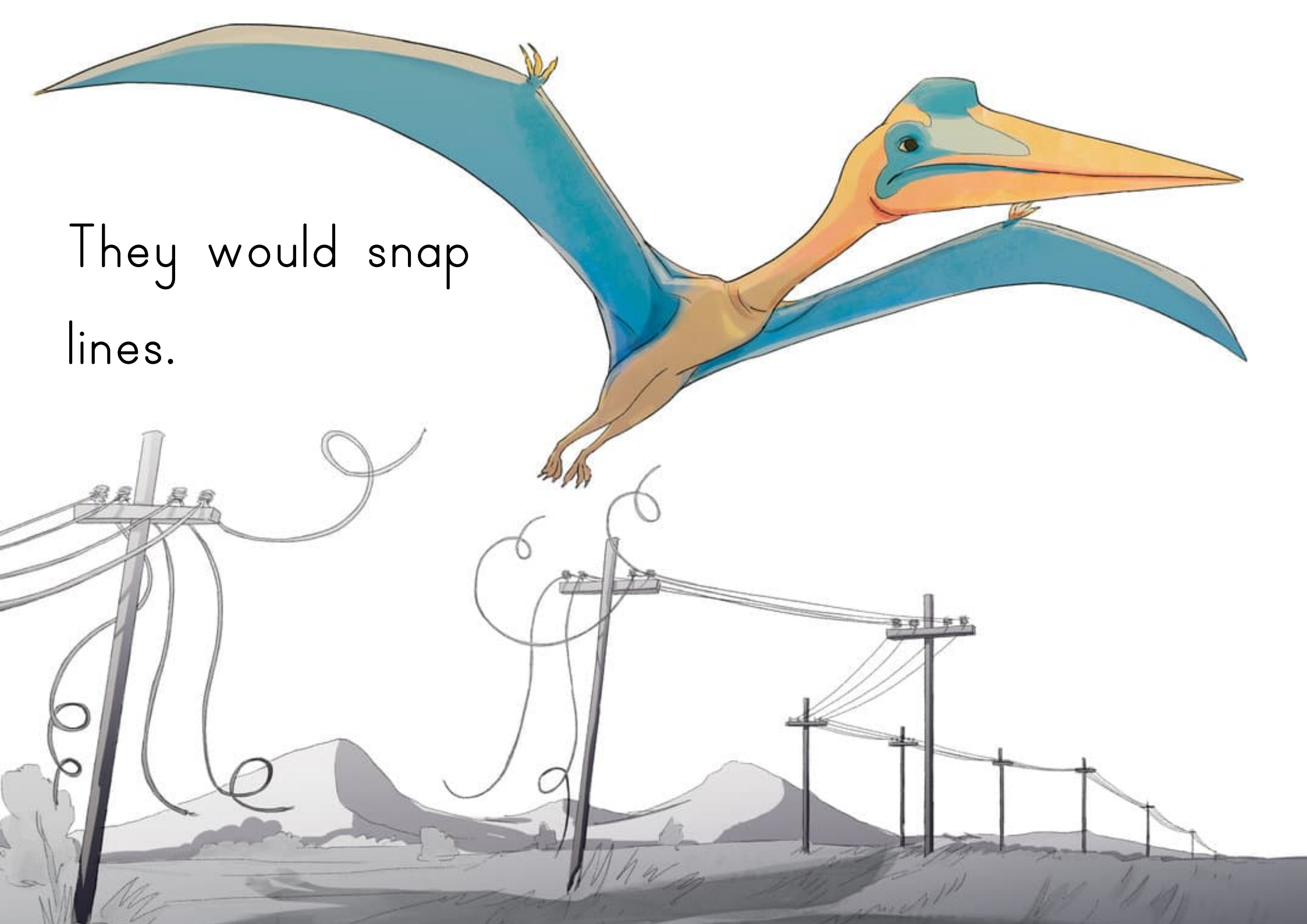
Would they ride on bikes?



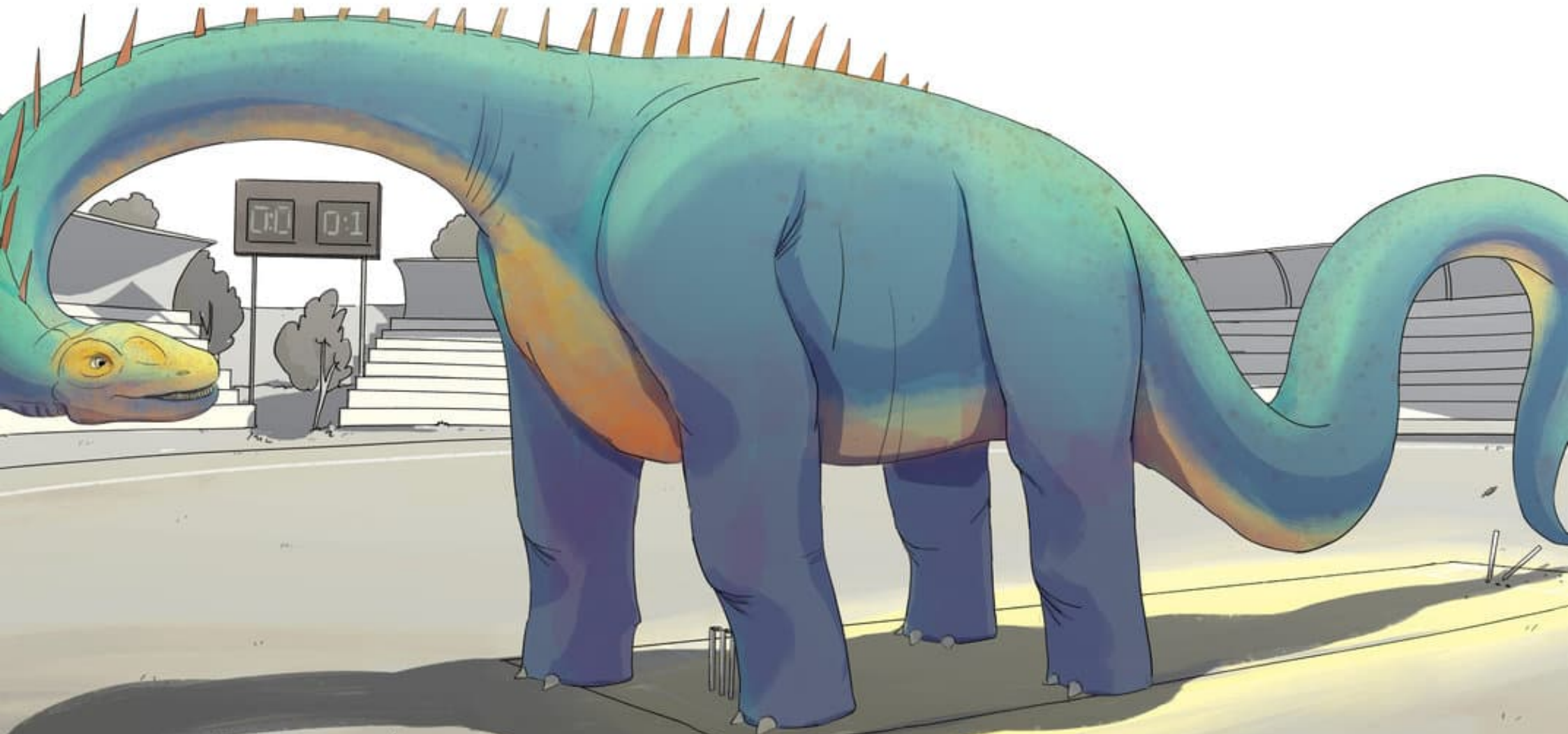
If dinos did not die, they would go to the store.

They would eat up all the grub.

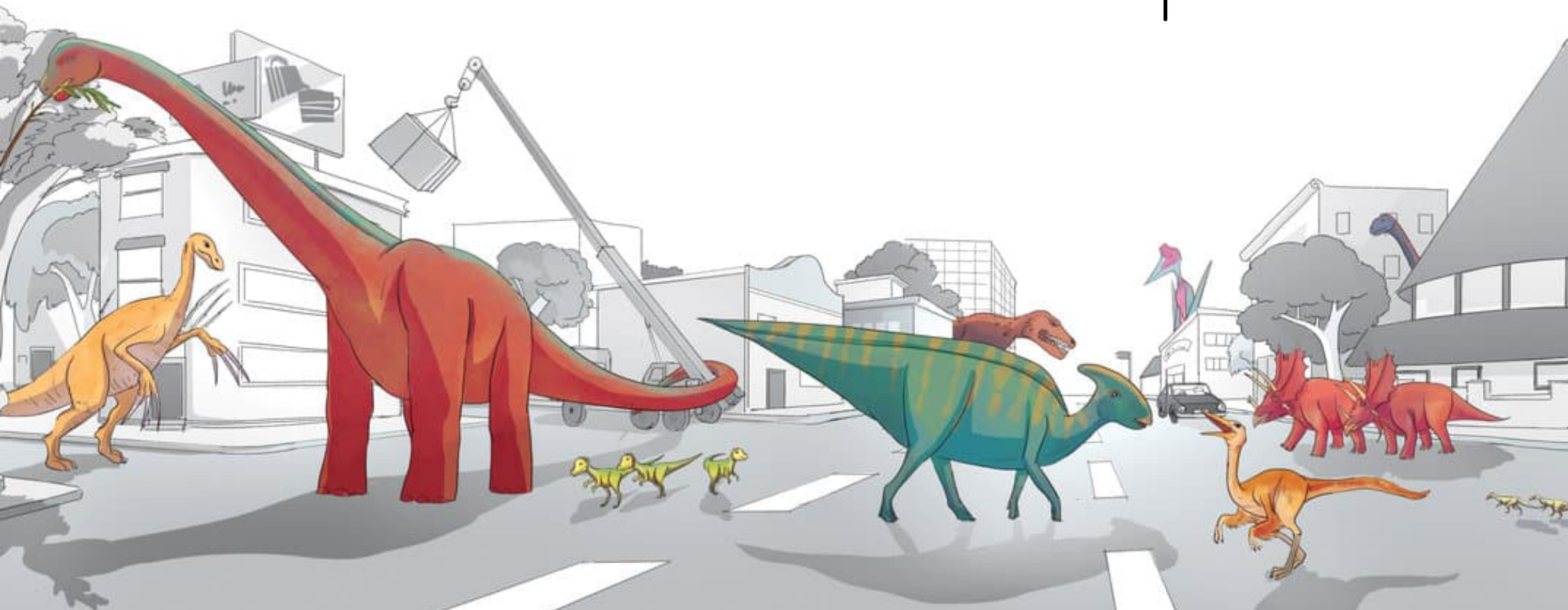


If dinos did not die, they would get in our homes.
