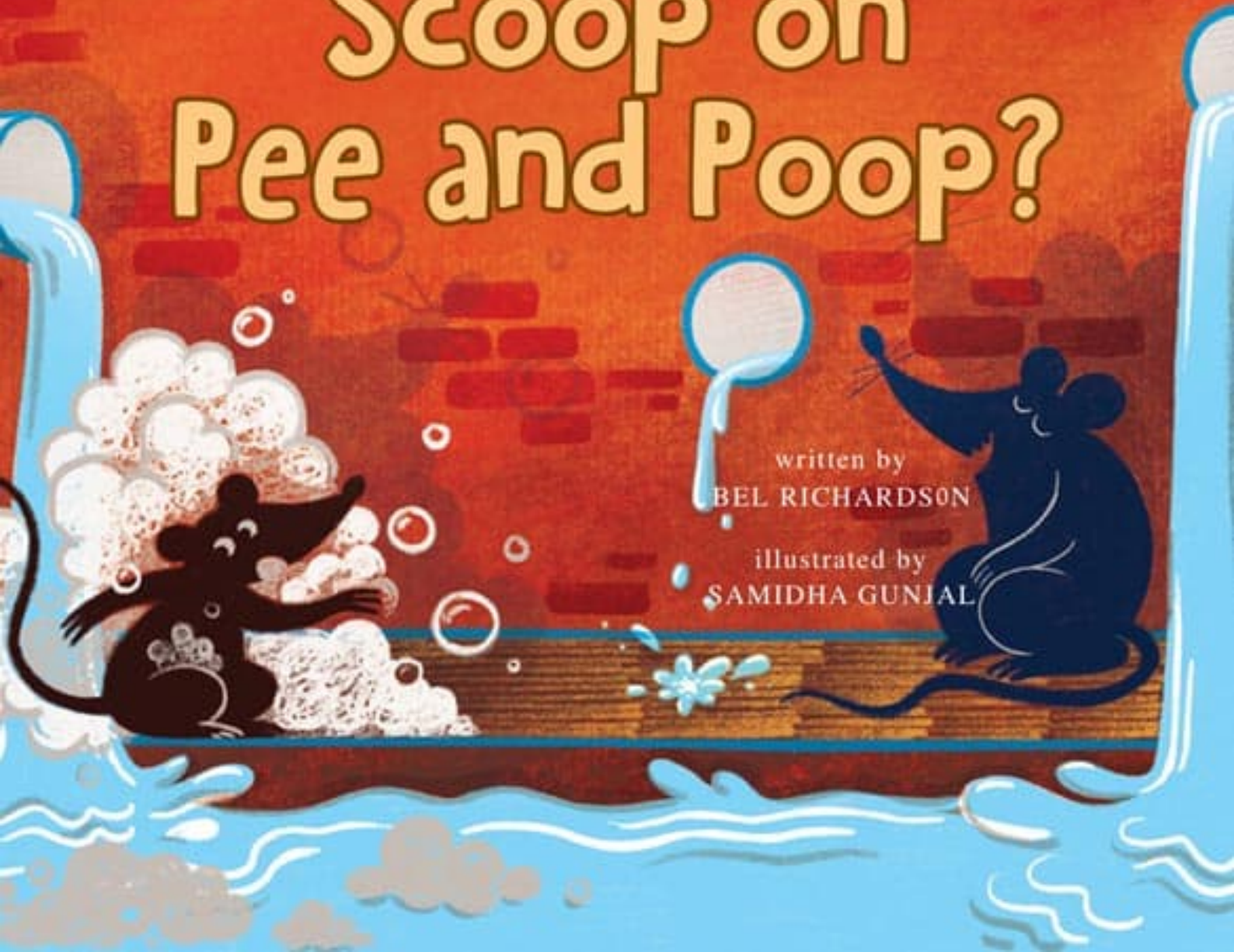

Down the pipe.



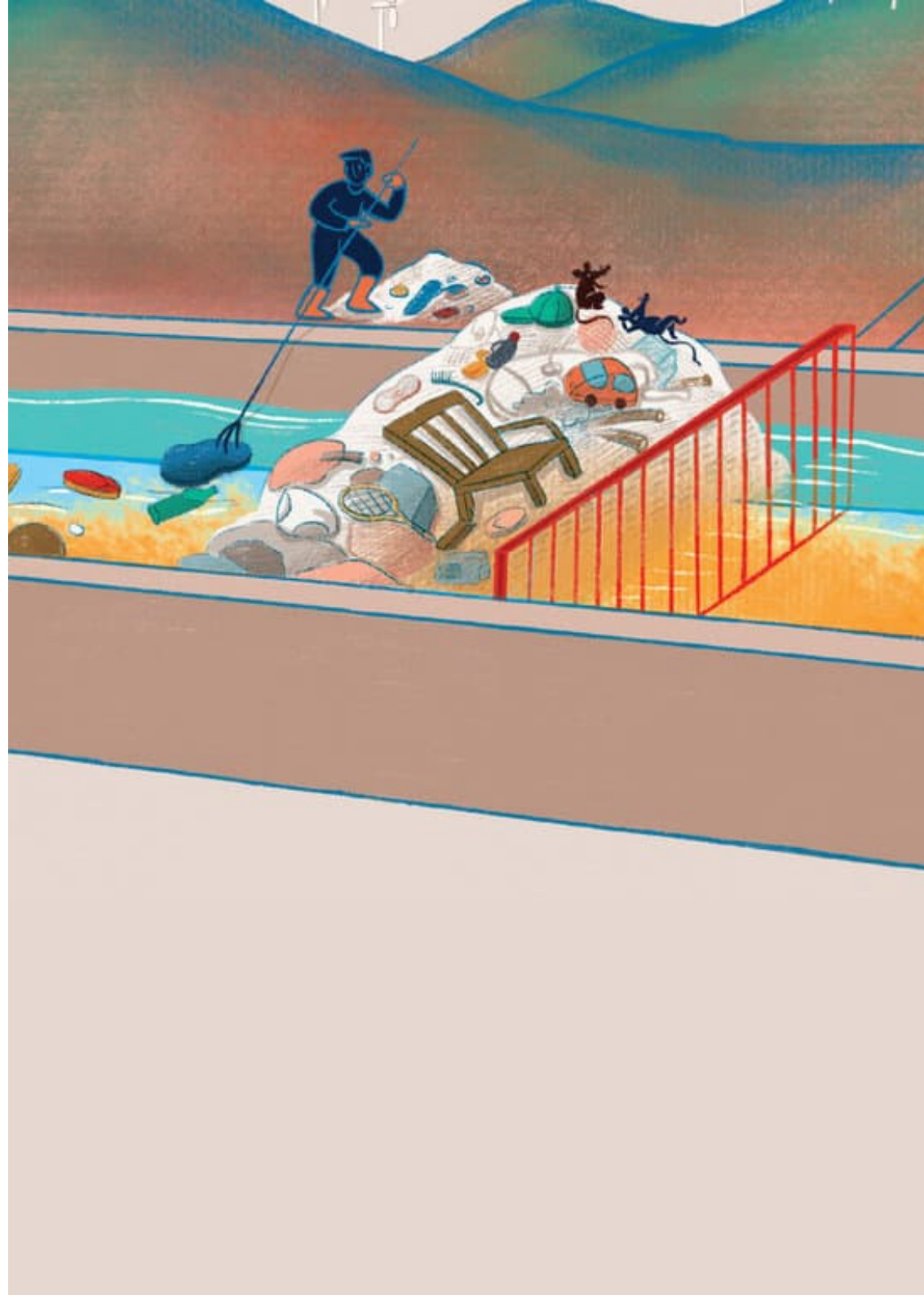
Pat finds a

off.

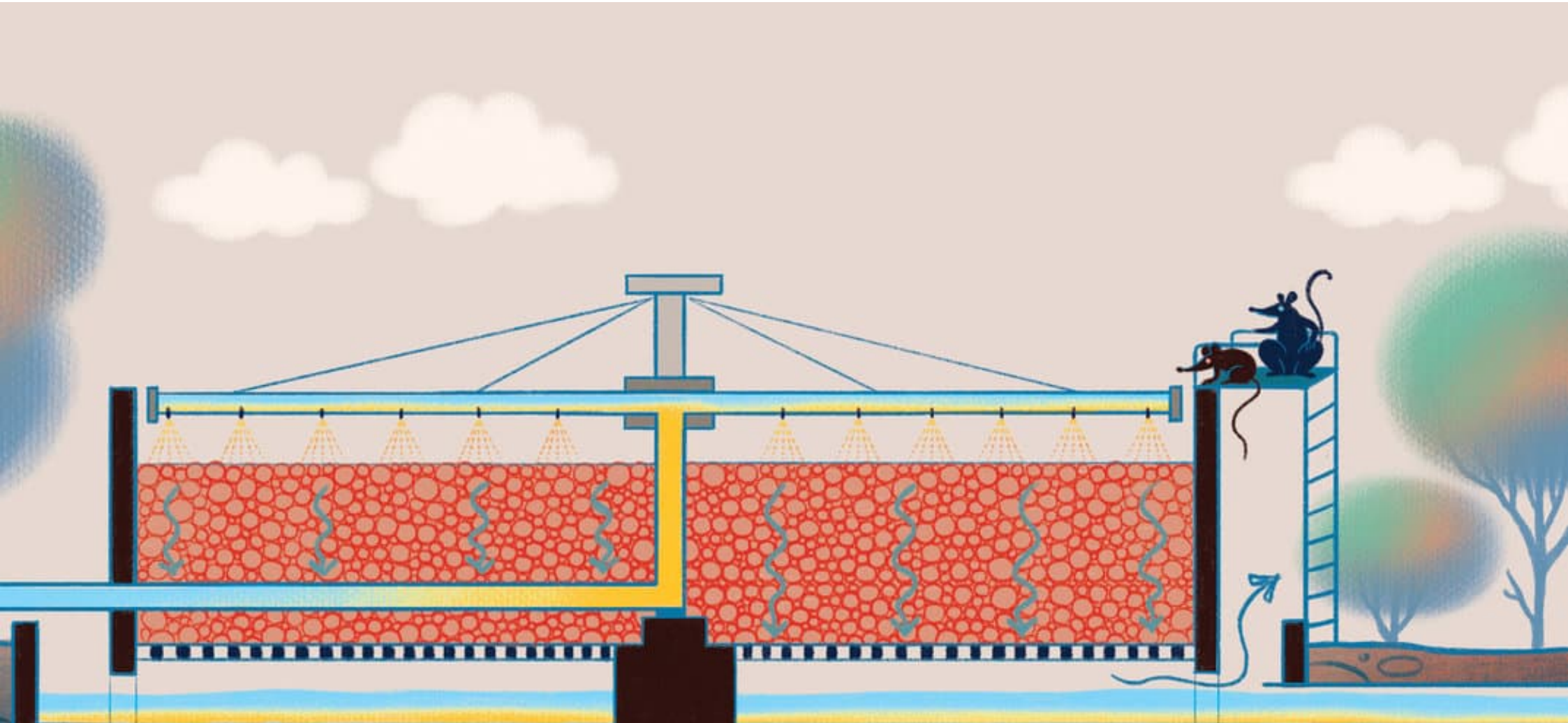
A big pond. A

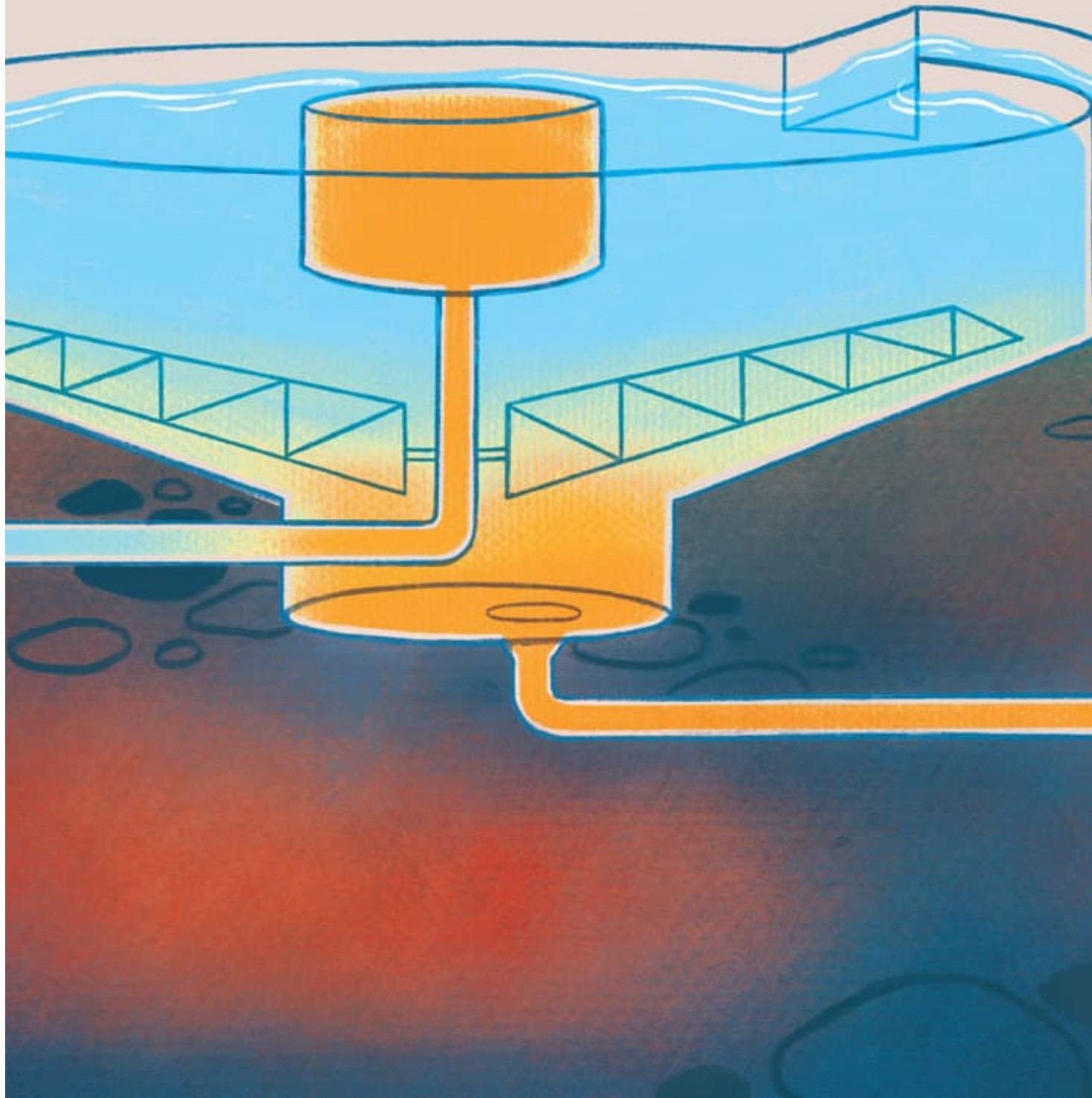


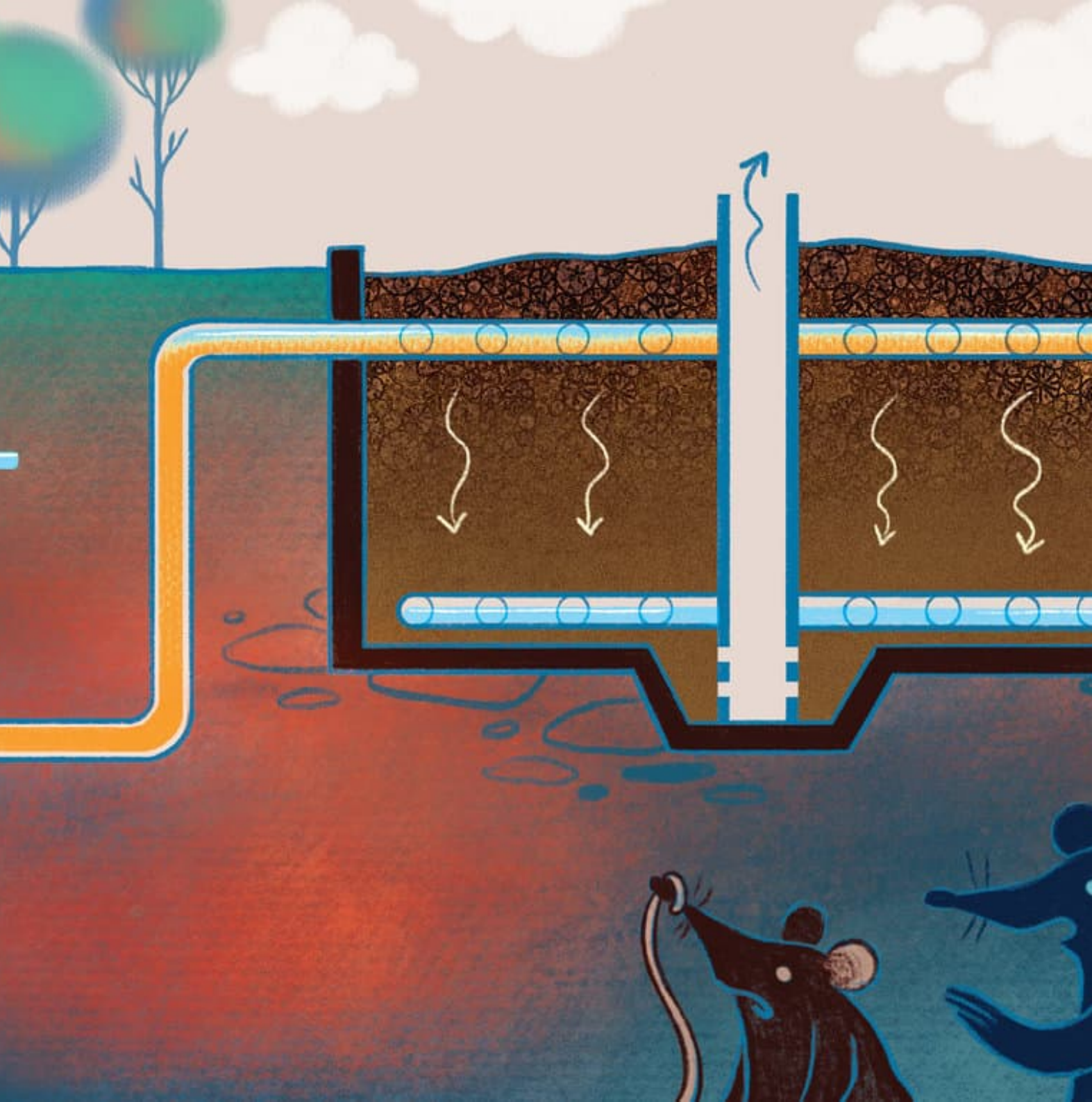

The tanks all have jobs.



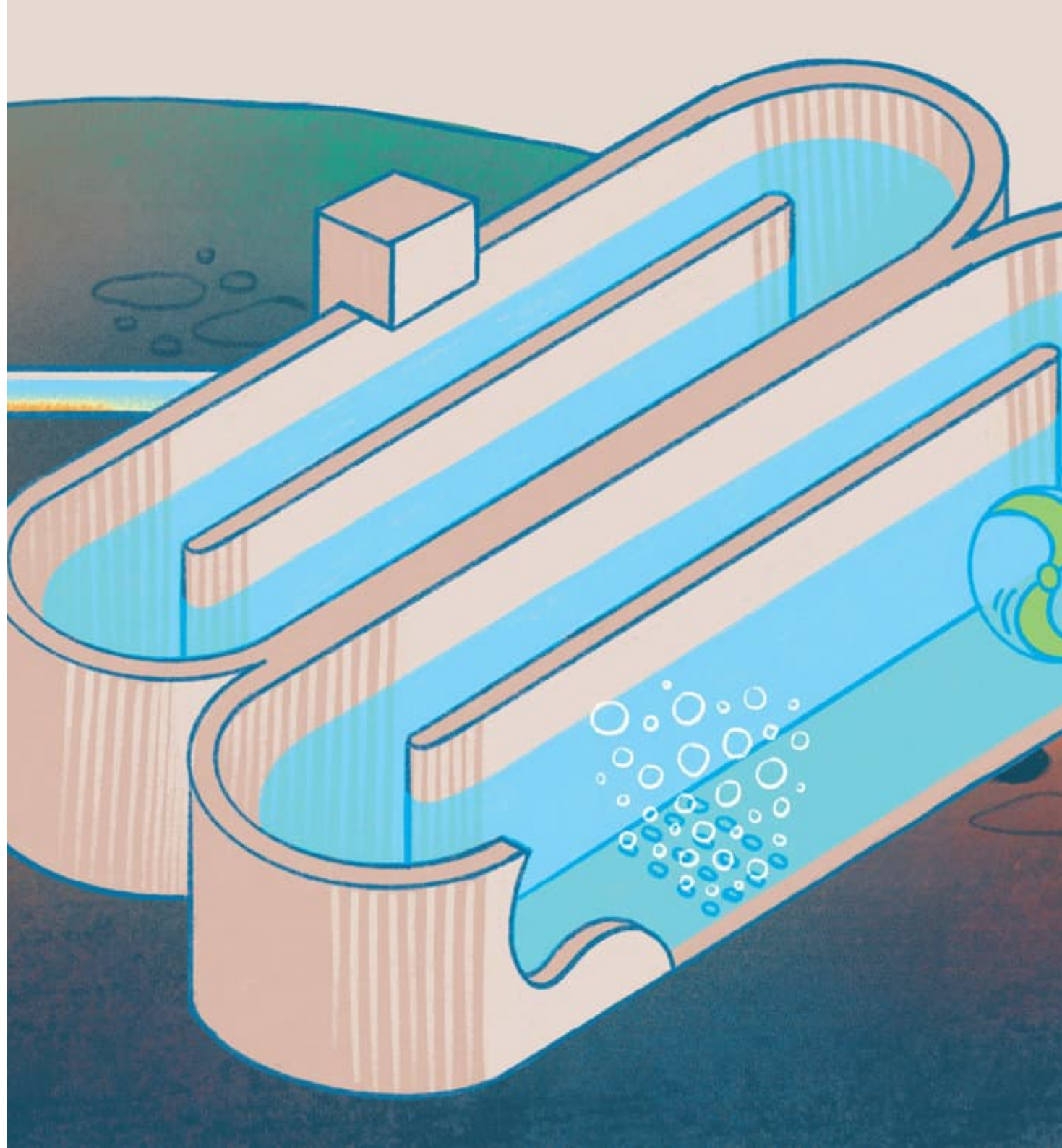

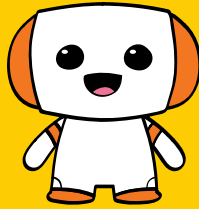
