


# IS THIS THE SEA?

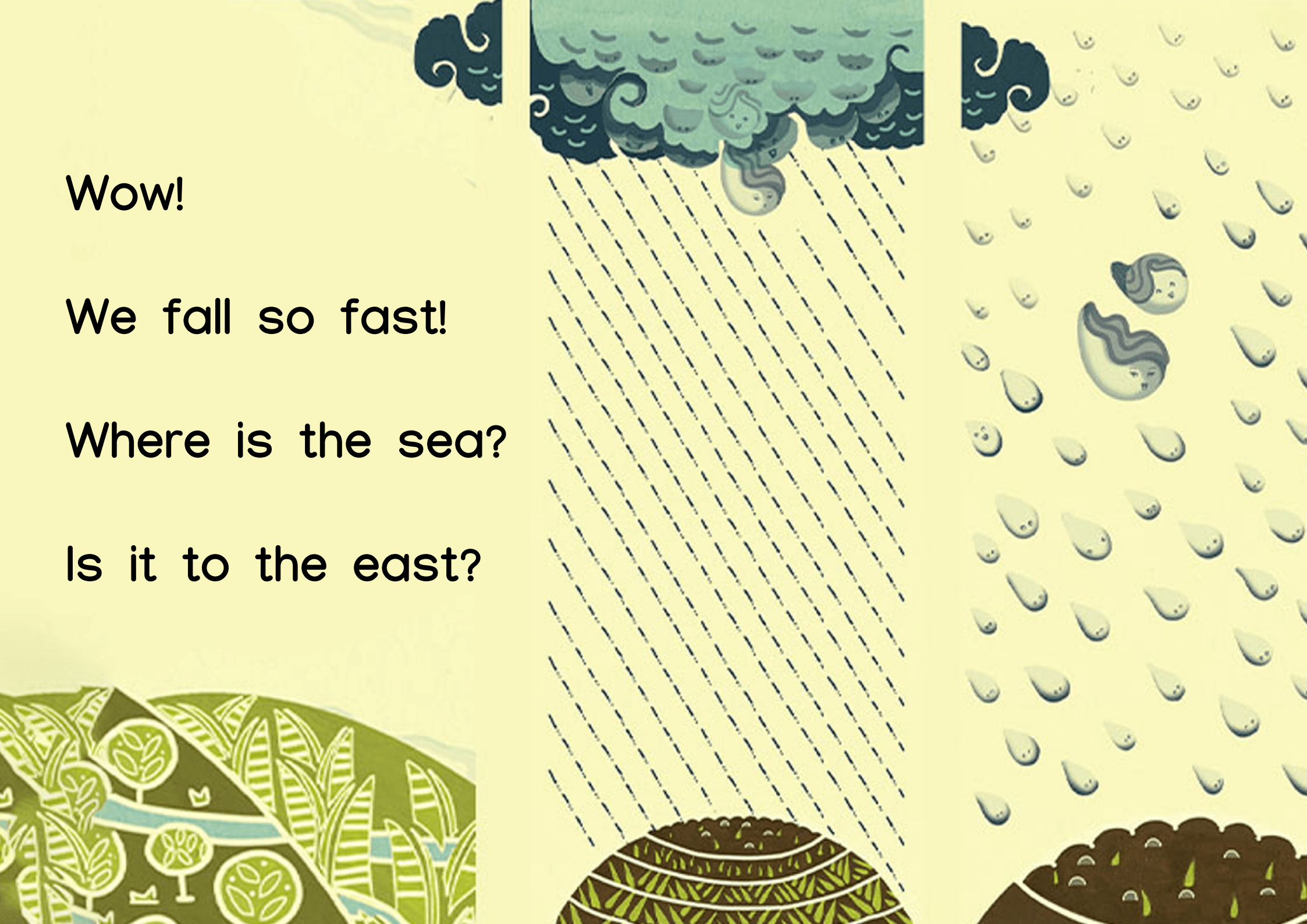



Wow!

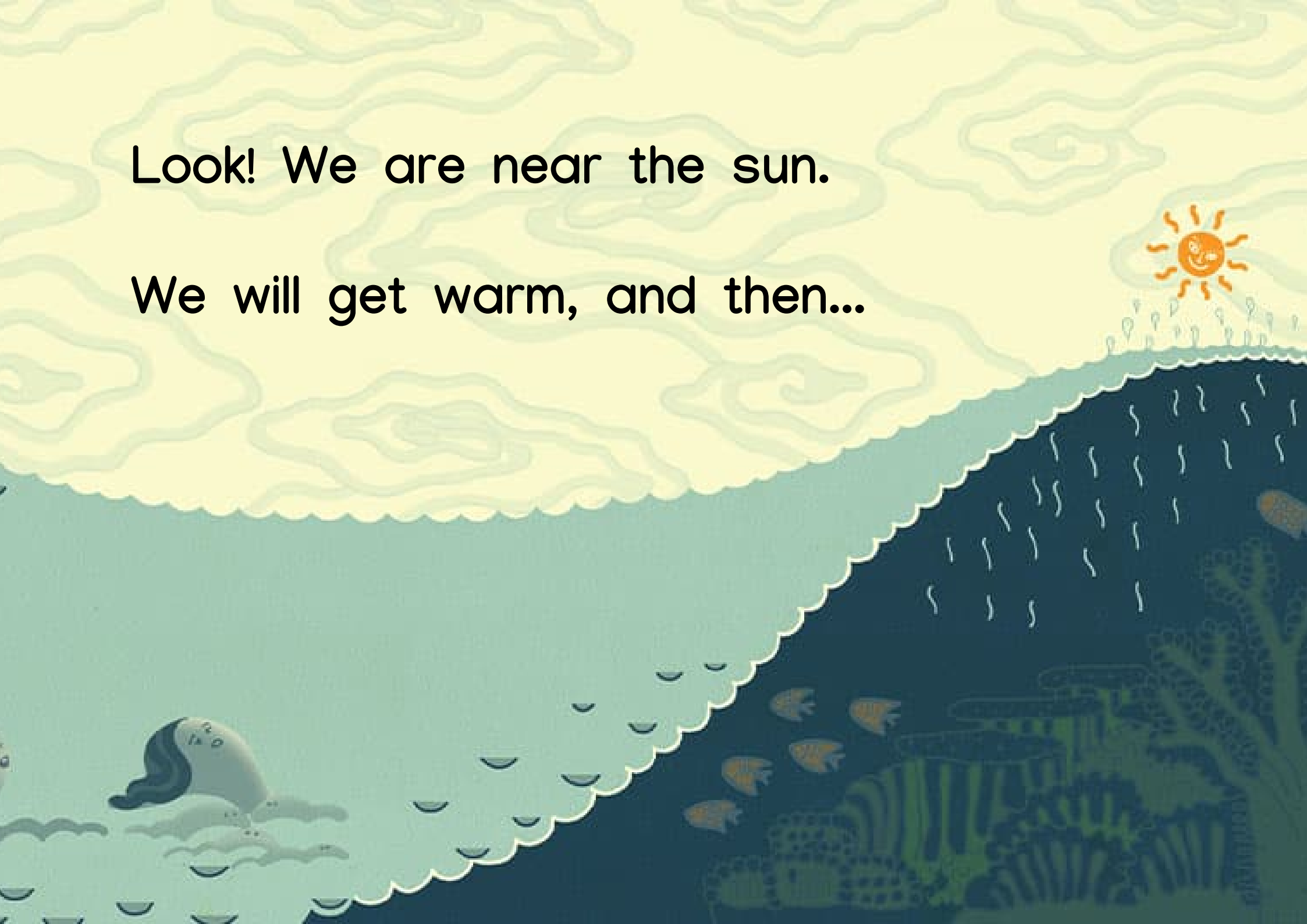


Yes! We are near to
