I need to wash and brush my hair a lot. We get it cut so that it grows strong and looks neat.

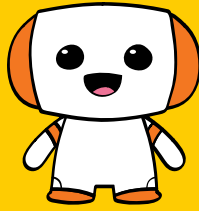


But at times, I like to
