We have a mango picnic for lunch. Gran has cut them up for us. I like to chew on the skin and the seed as well.




Back to work. Our friends come to help. We will send some mangoes home with them in a basket as a thank you.







We load the mangoes into baskets and send them down. Then we sort them on a blanket. We will sell some for cheap and some for more money.
