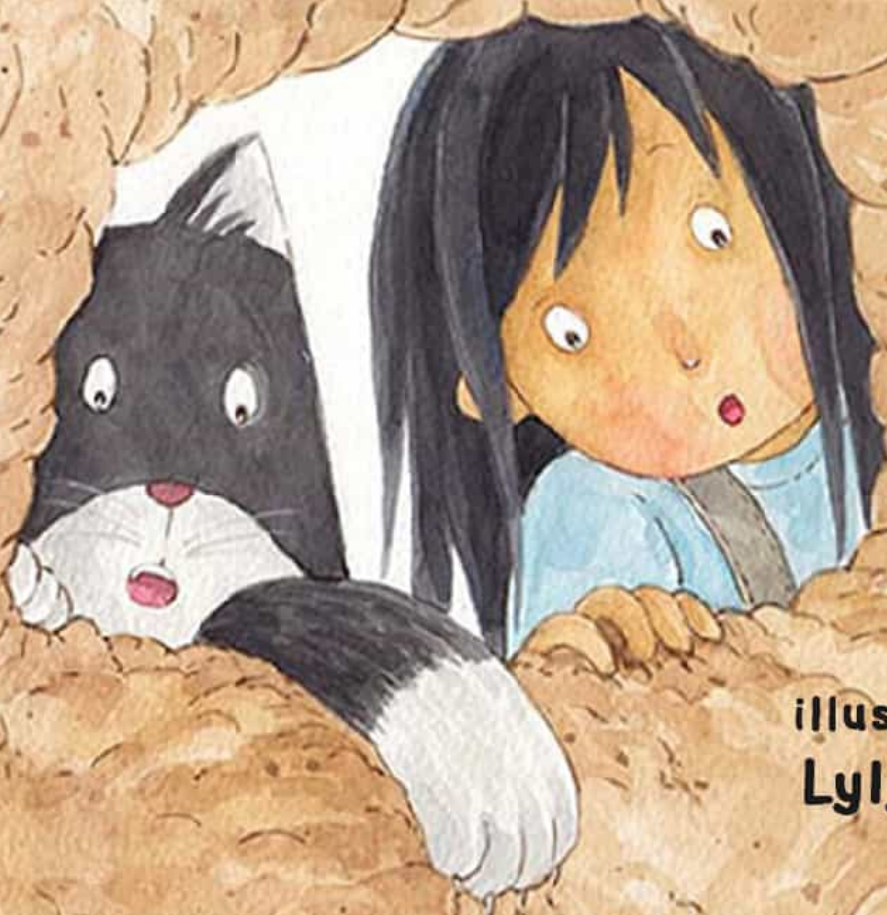


CATS AND CRABS

fast in the soil.



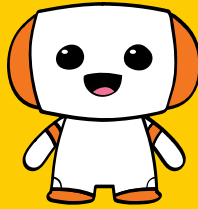
Soon they are gone.
