Ted is blind and cannot see, but that doesn't matter.

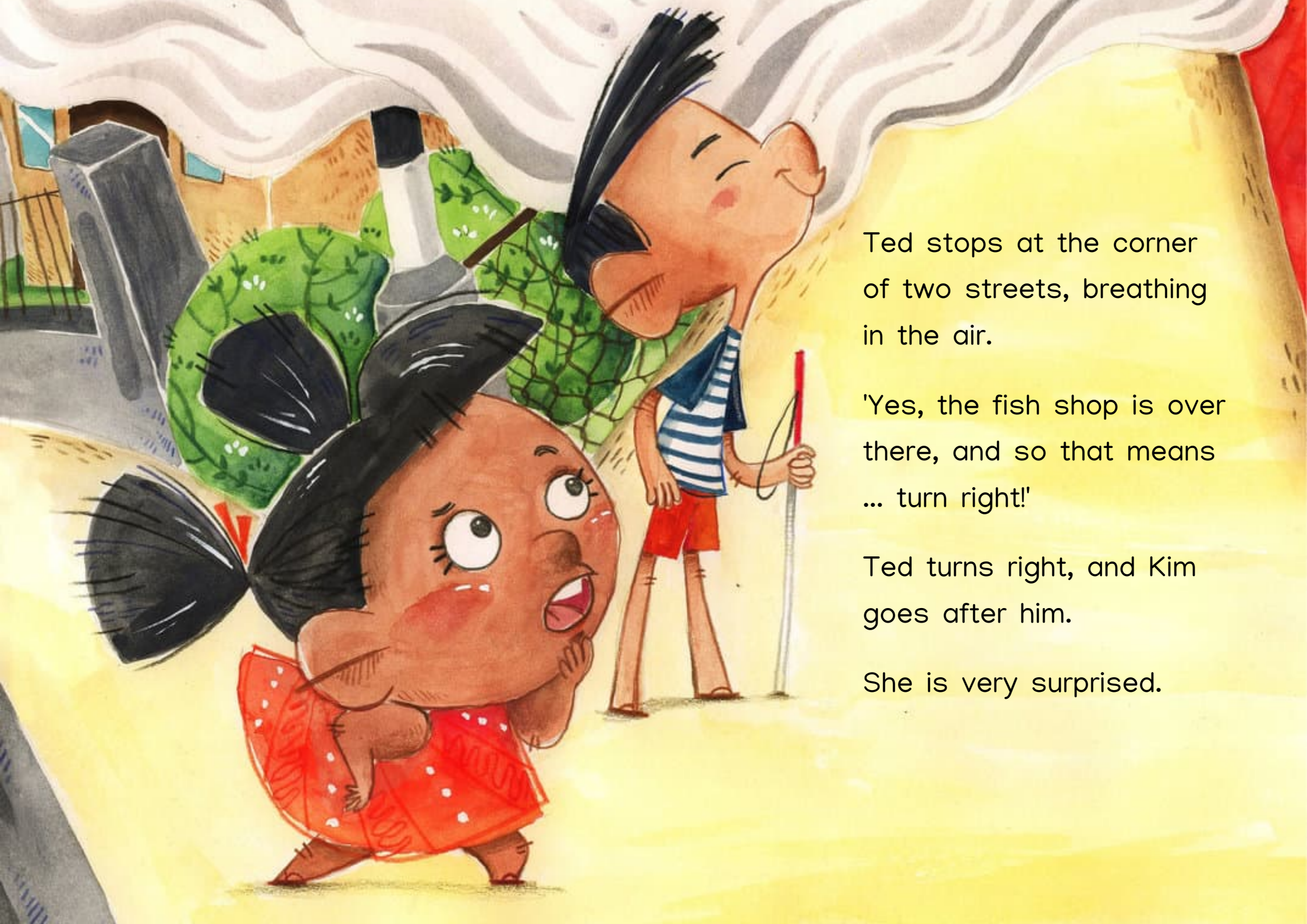
He knows the way!

Ted turns right, and Kim goes after him.

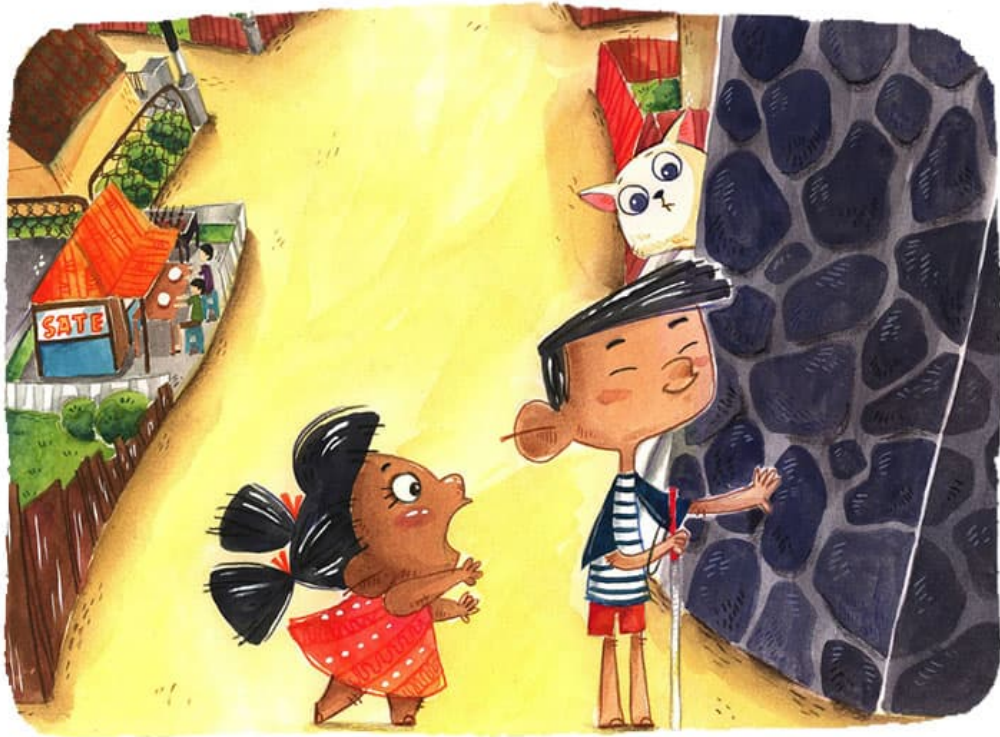
She is very surprised.

'Don't worry, Kim, I know it is there,' Ted walks around it, his shoes still dry.

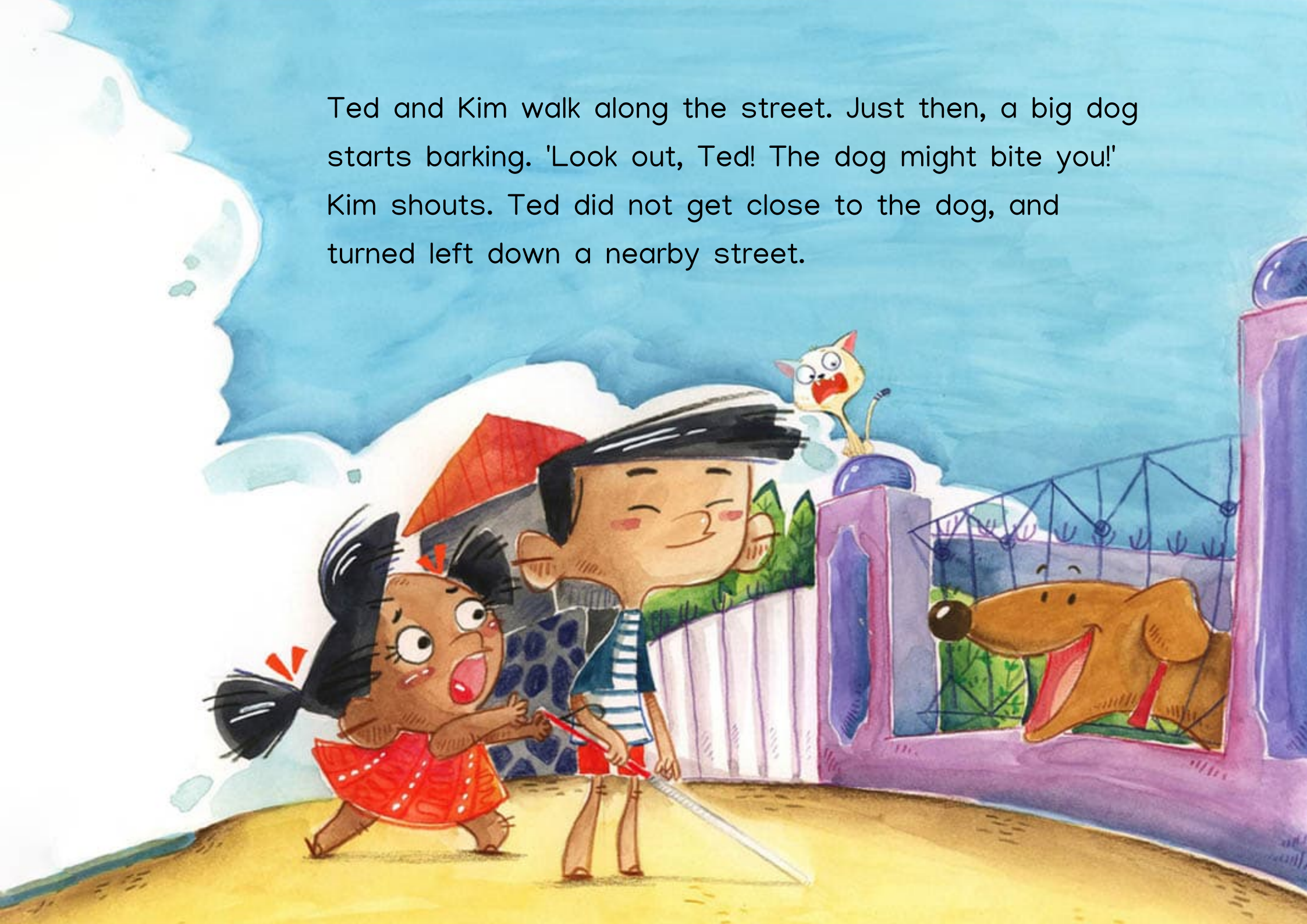


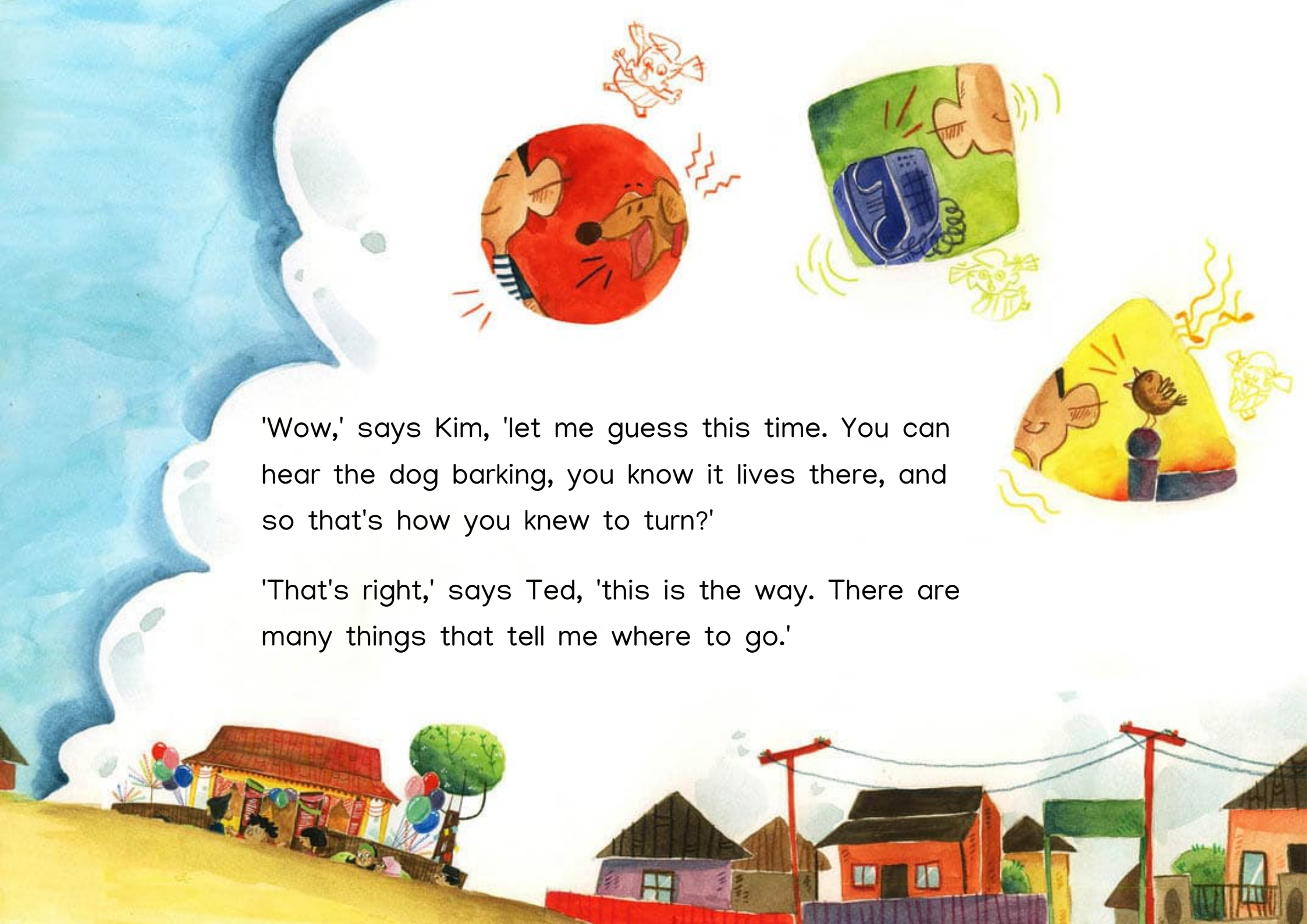
'This stick is helping me see,' Ted says.
