

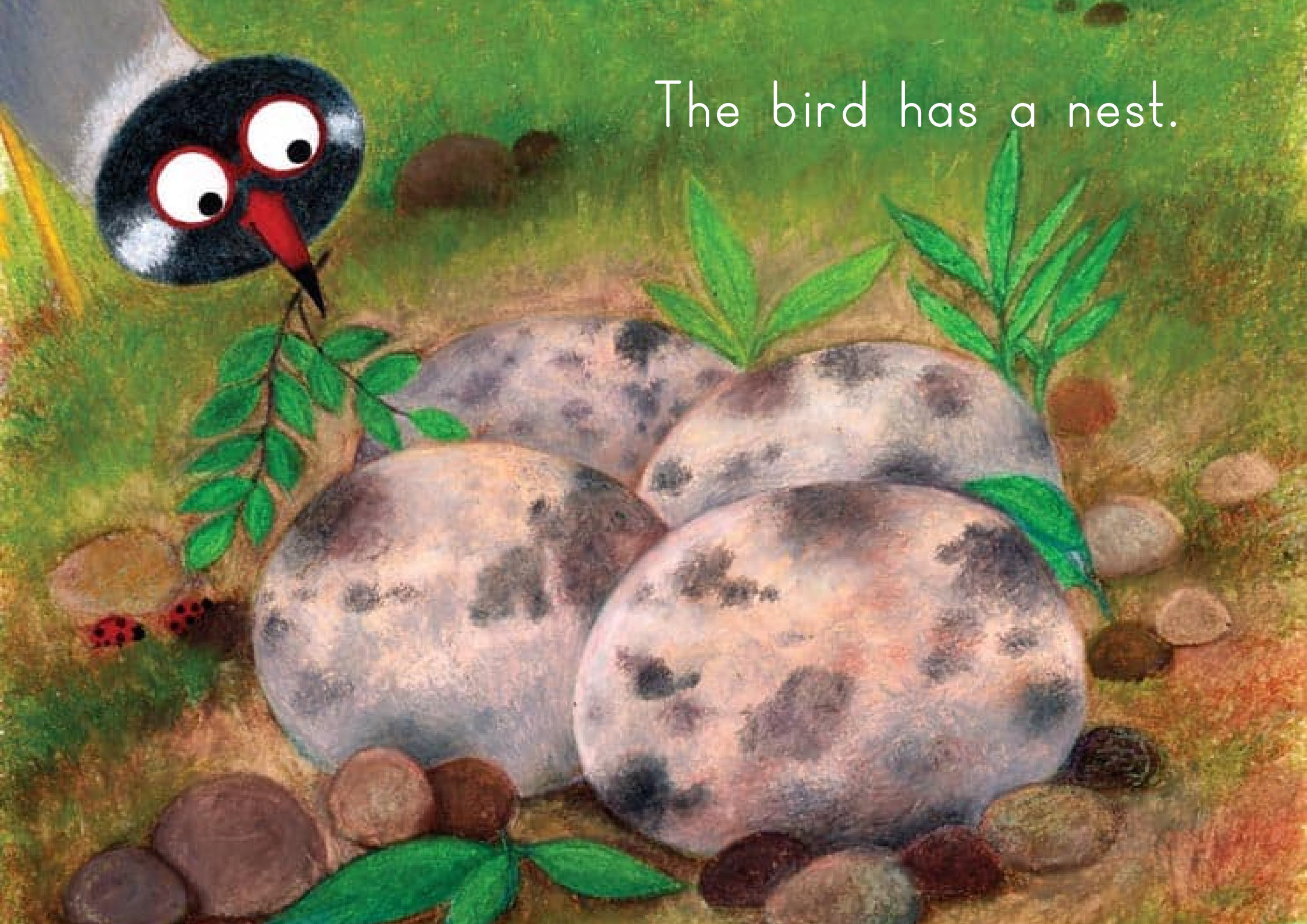

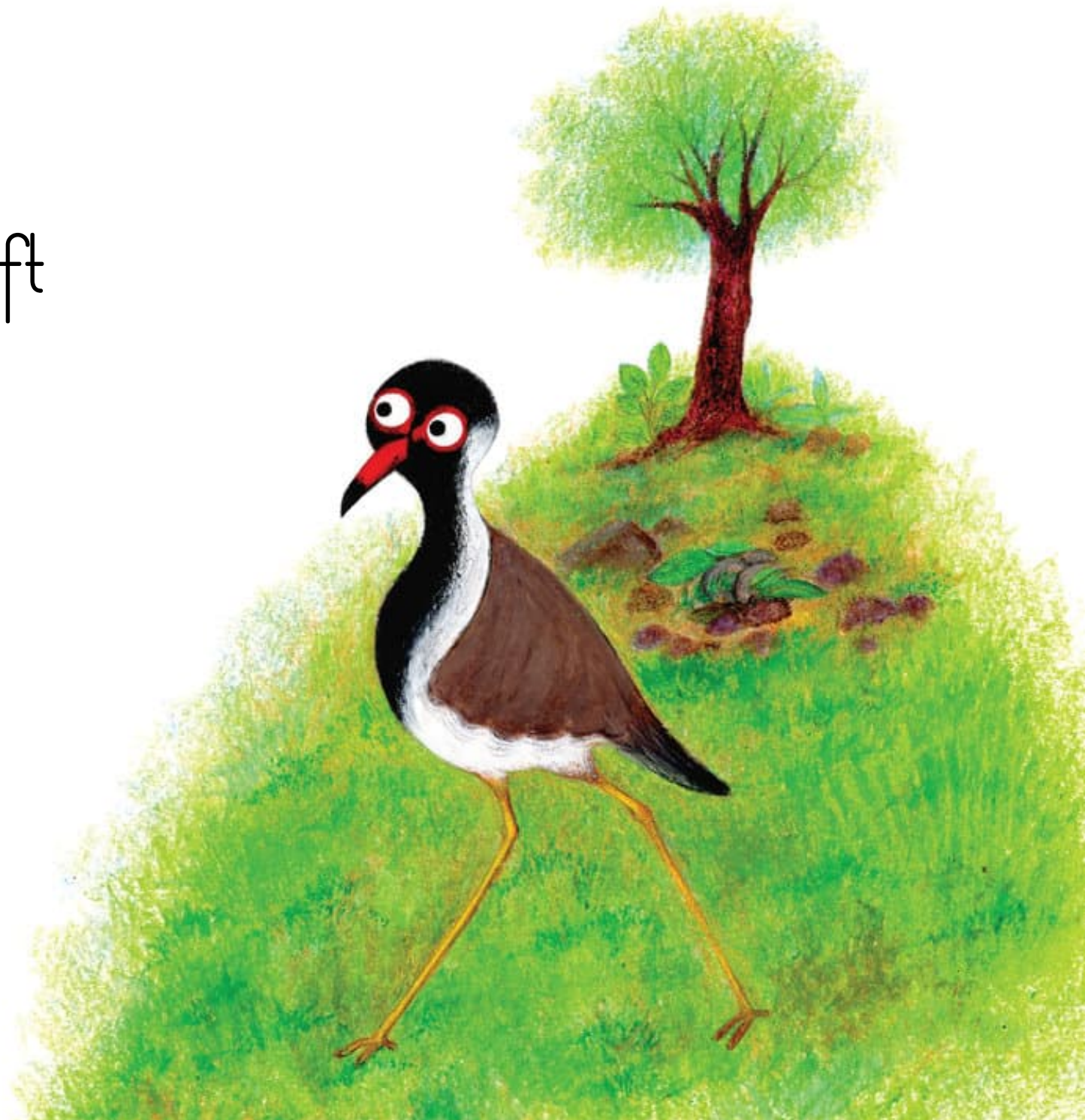
It sits on the nest.
