Is it a nose?

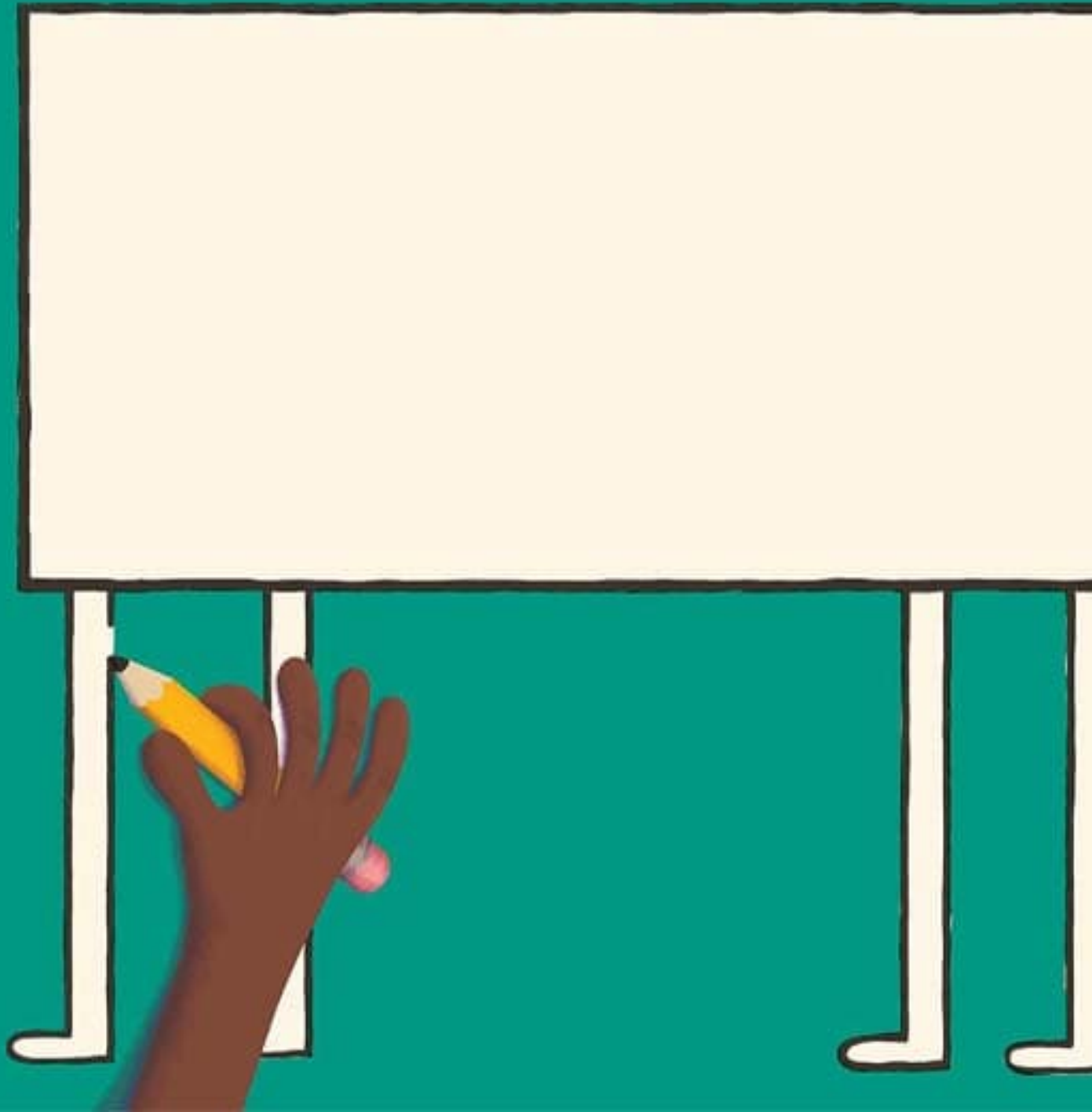




We are in for

gets a smile.

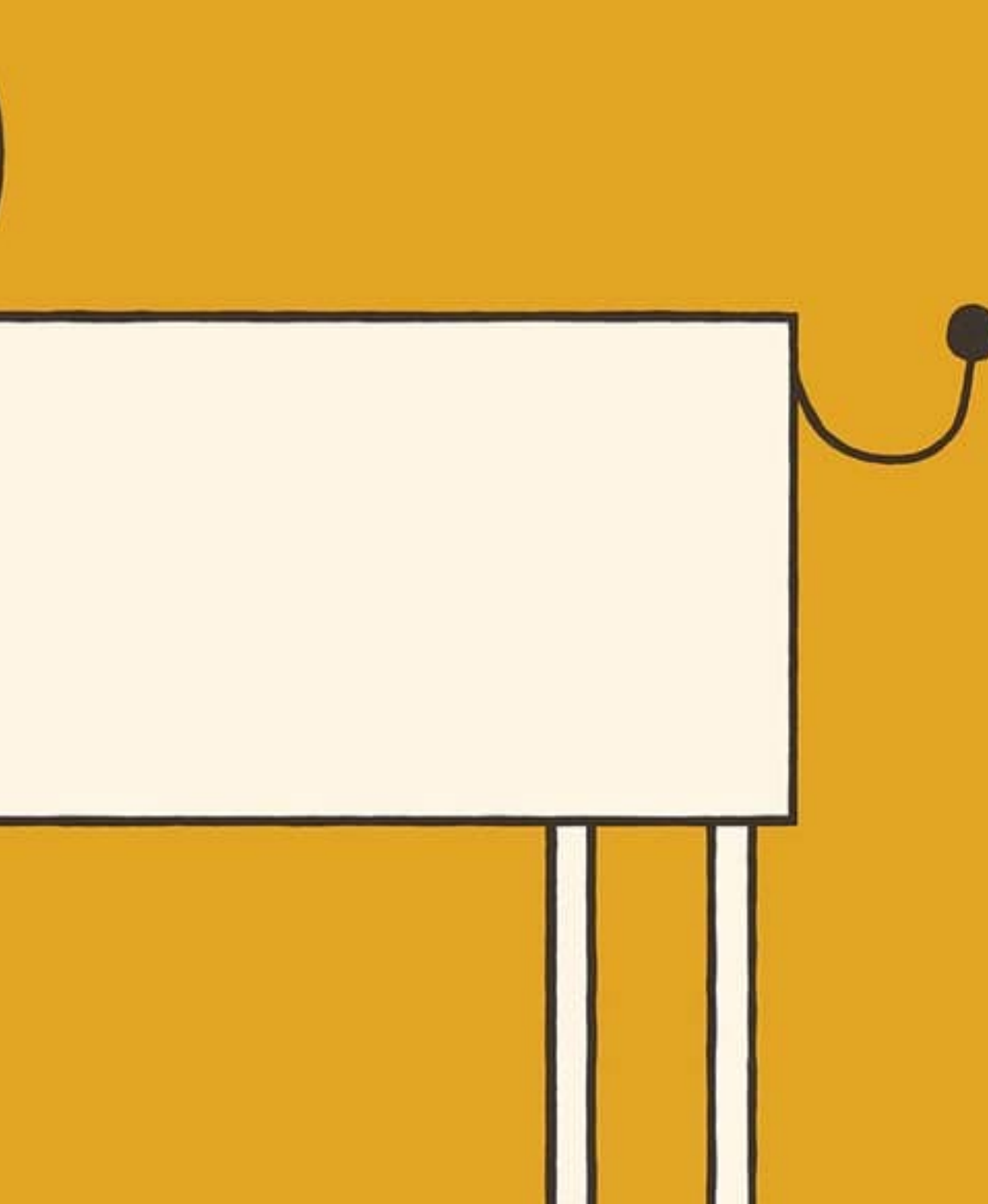
What has Paul

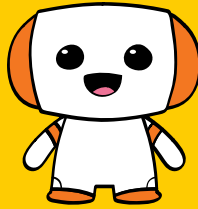
The dog is so
