





It is Abi's job to keep Kobi clean and happy.

Tonight there is a celebration parade.






Abi has brought some of the special grass Kobi likes to help steady him.

He was so busy getting Kobi ready, he forgot to have lunch. He is tired and hungry and thinks he can duck away for just a moment to get something to eat.








While he is gone, Kobi starts to search for Abi.

Abi comes back just in time.









He sings to Kobi, the white calf, and calms him with his voice. He feeds him the sweet grass that the buffalo really likes.
