

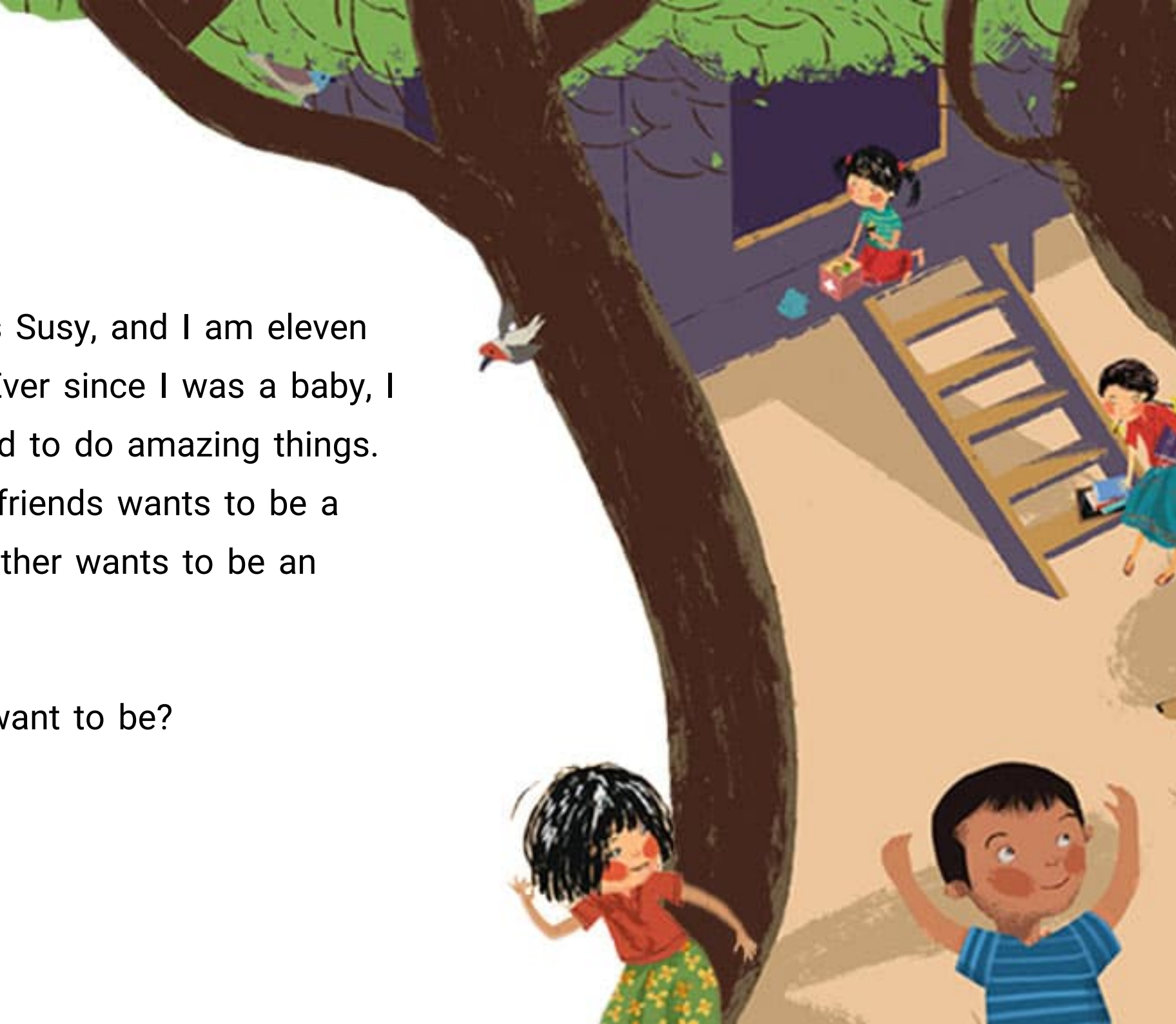
# I CAN DO MAGIC

I need to look like a magician!



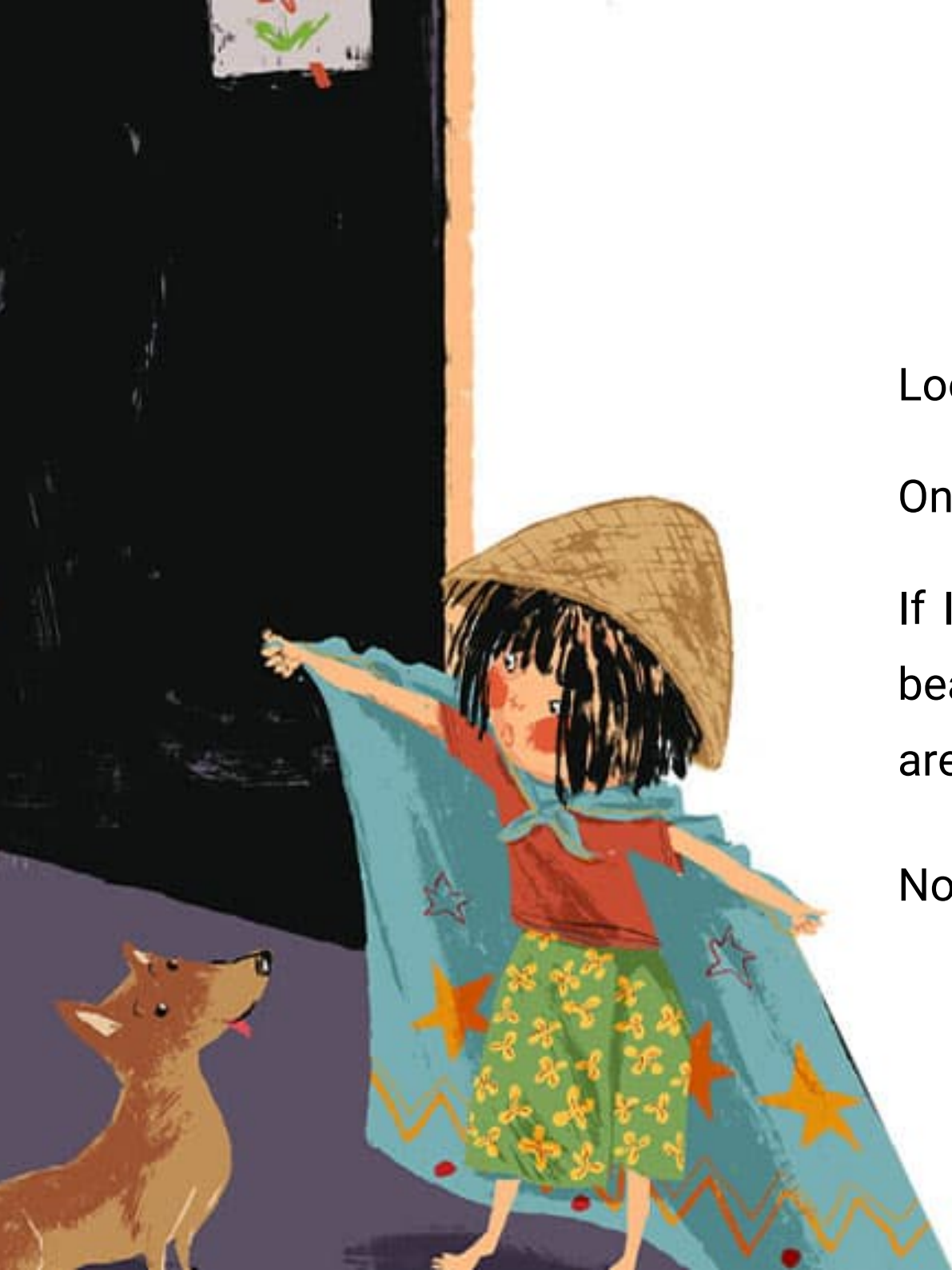
We don't have much in the house,

My show is a success!

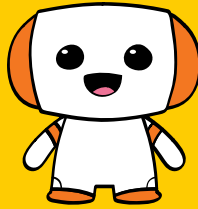
They want me to do it again next week.
