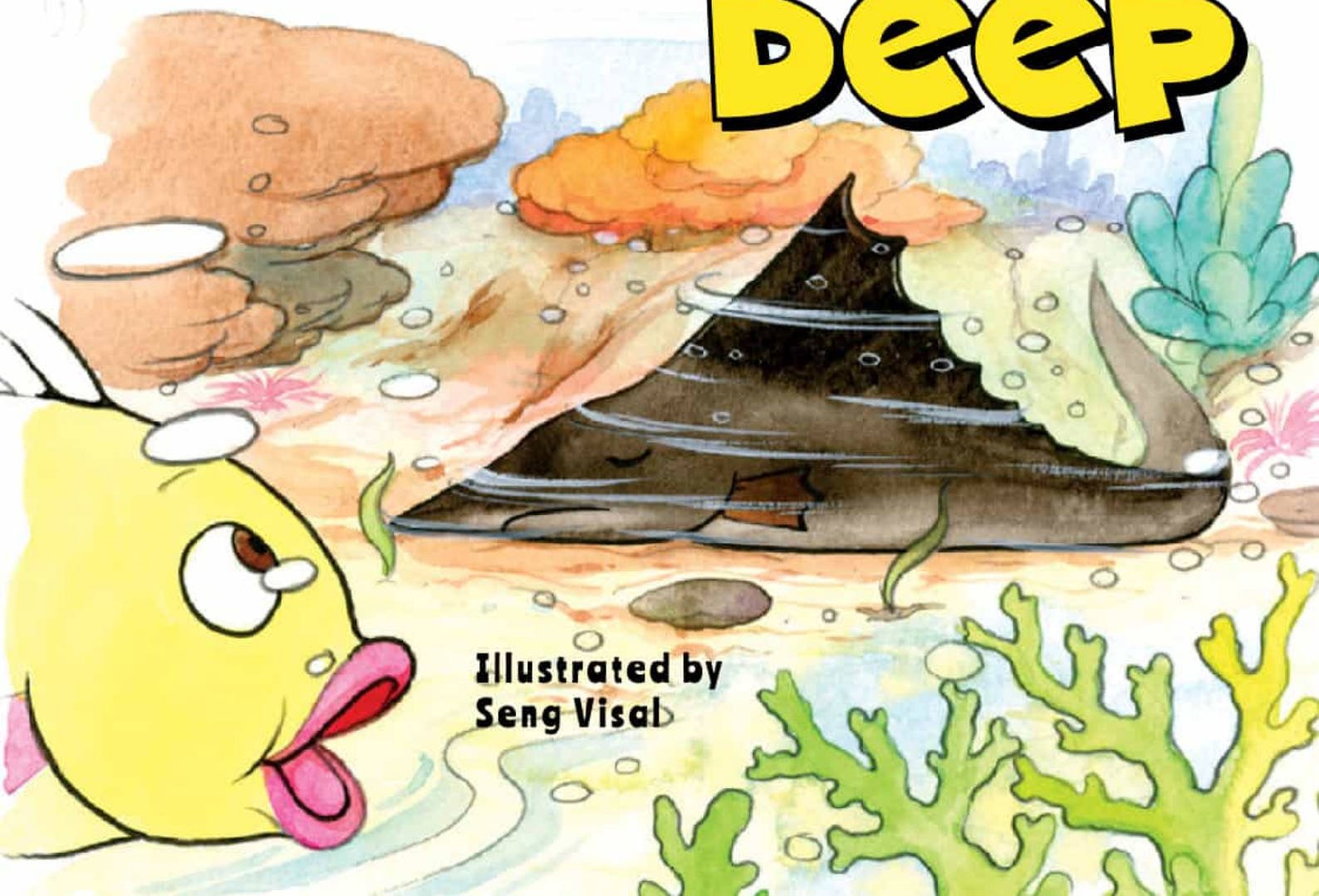


# THE LITTLE FISH GOES DEEP



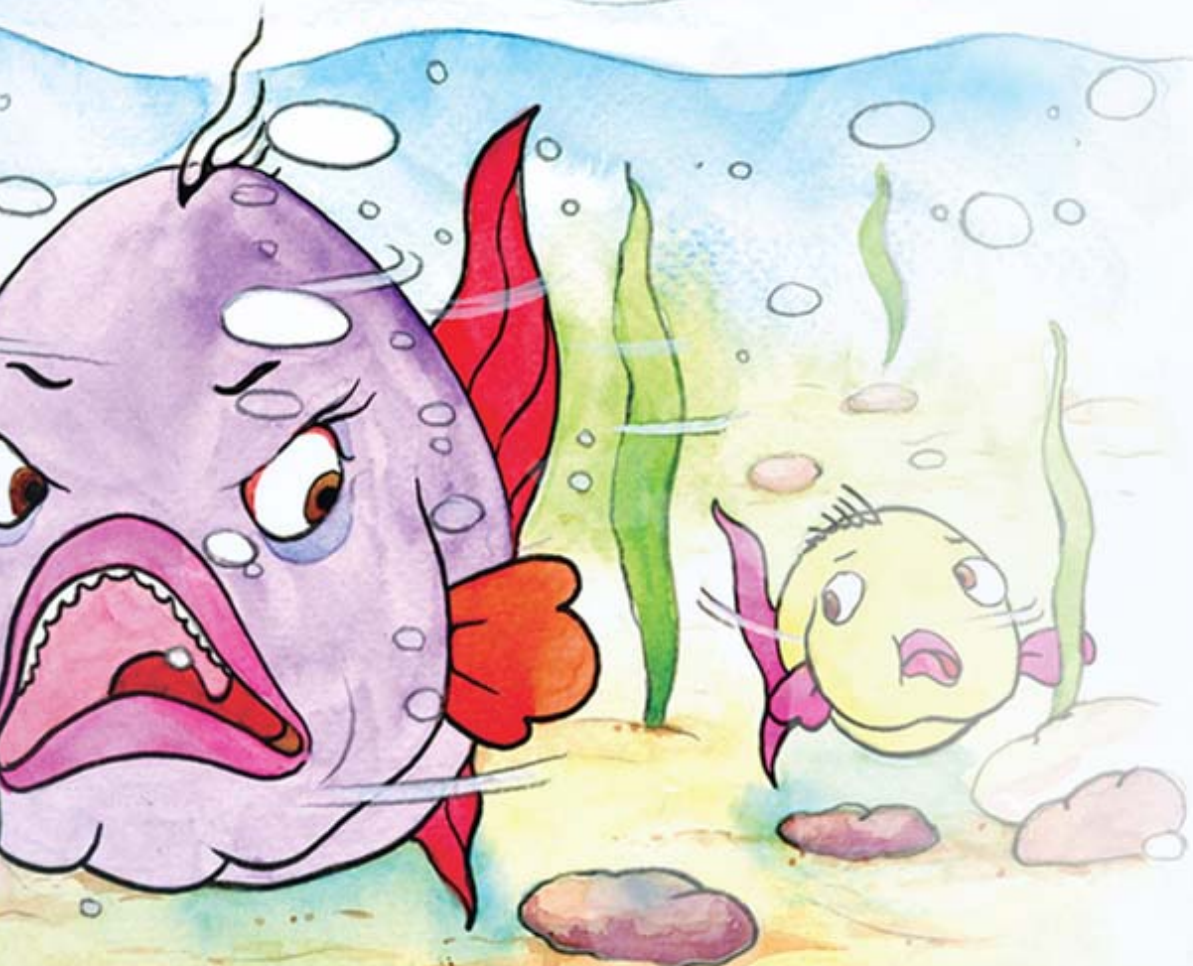

she says.

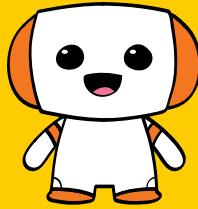


The little fish is glad
