over her head.





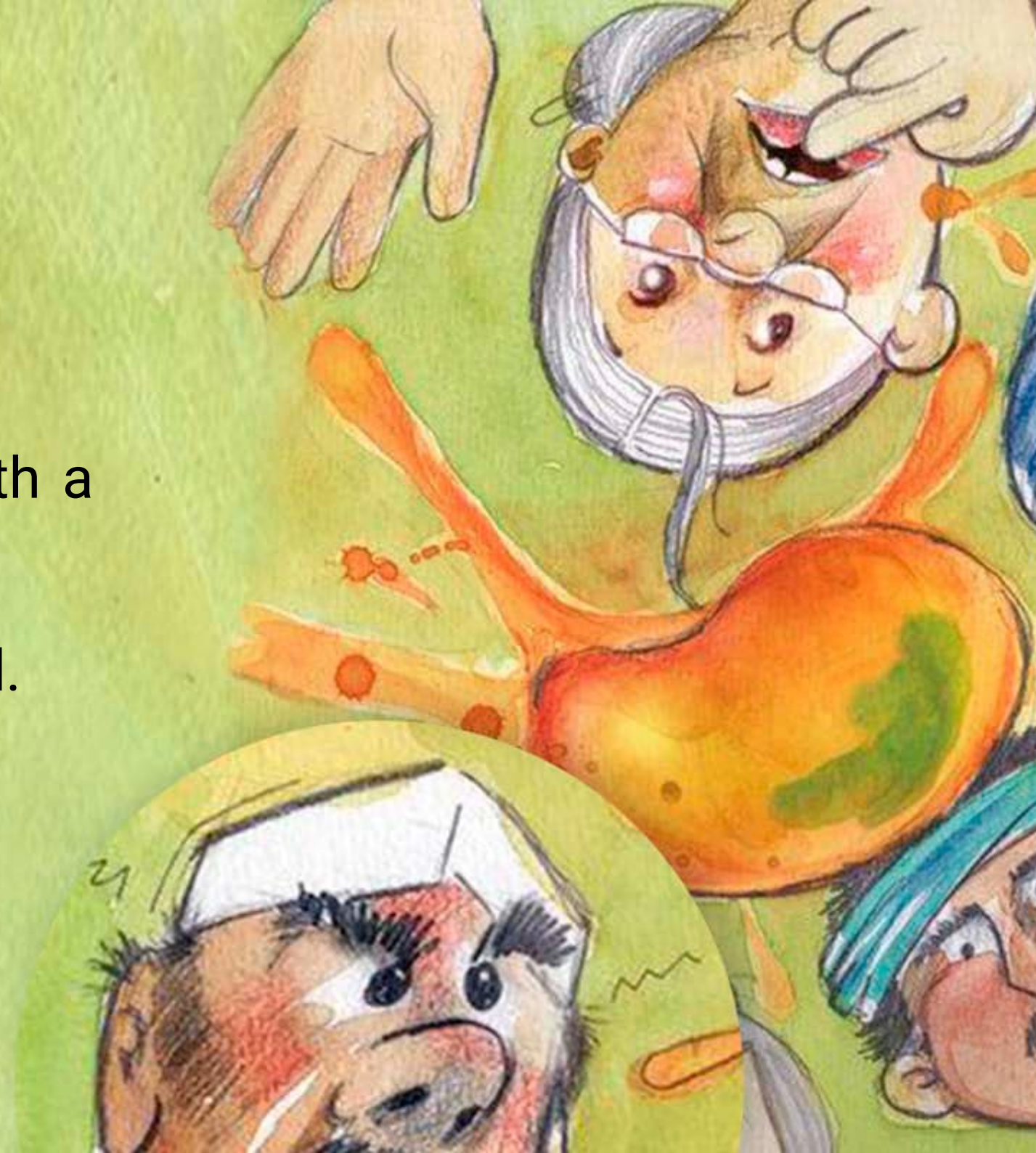
Out in the town, the

for juggling.

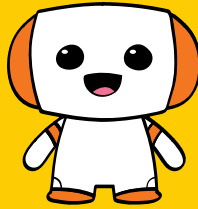
Gran goes flip,
