

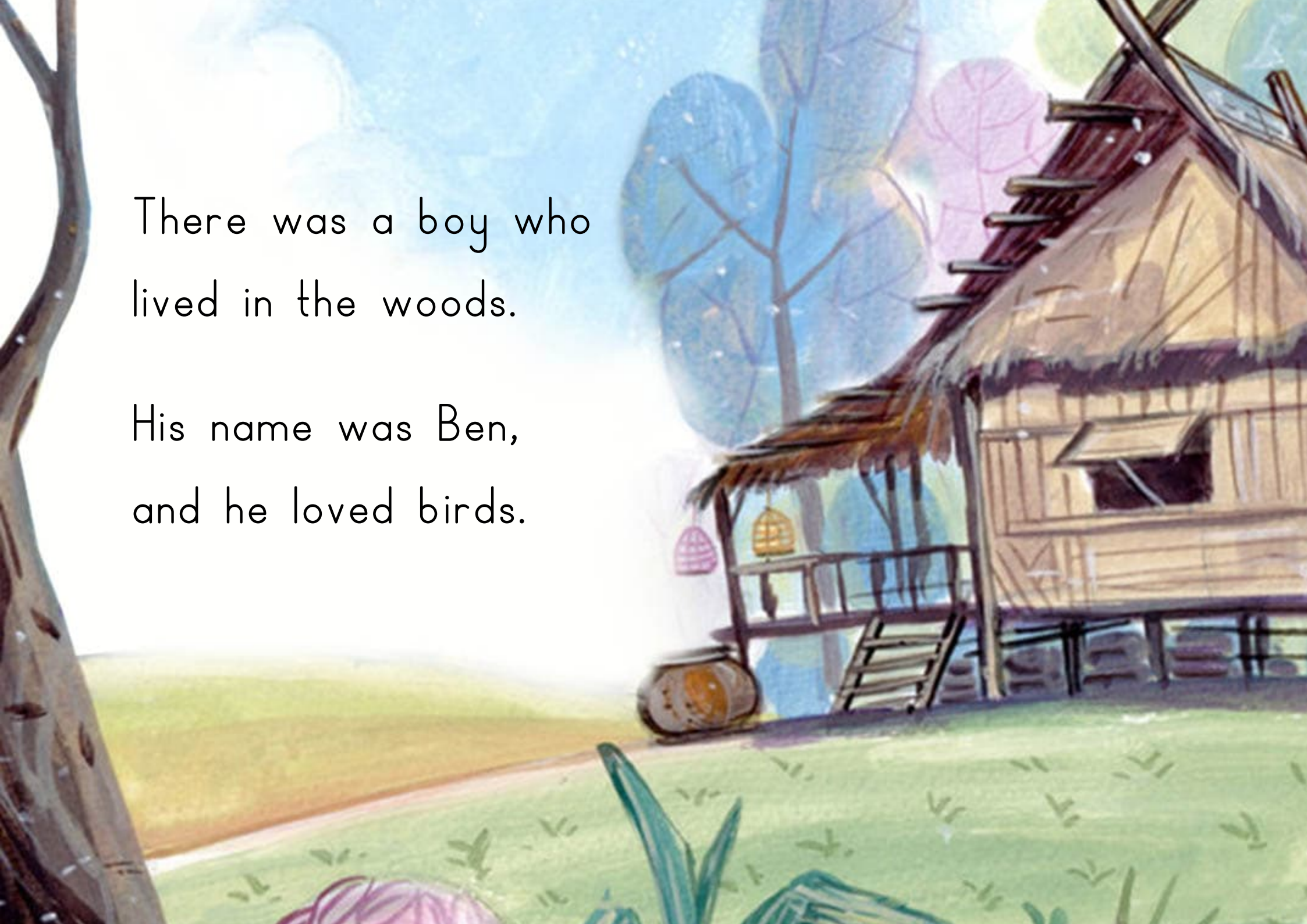
Bird in a Cage

were in a cage.

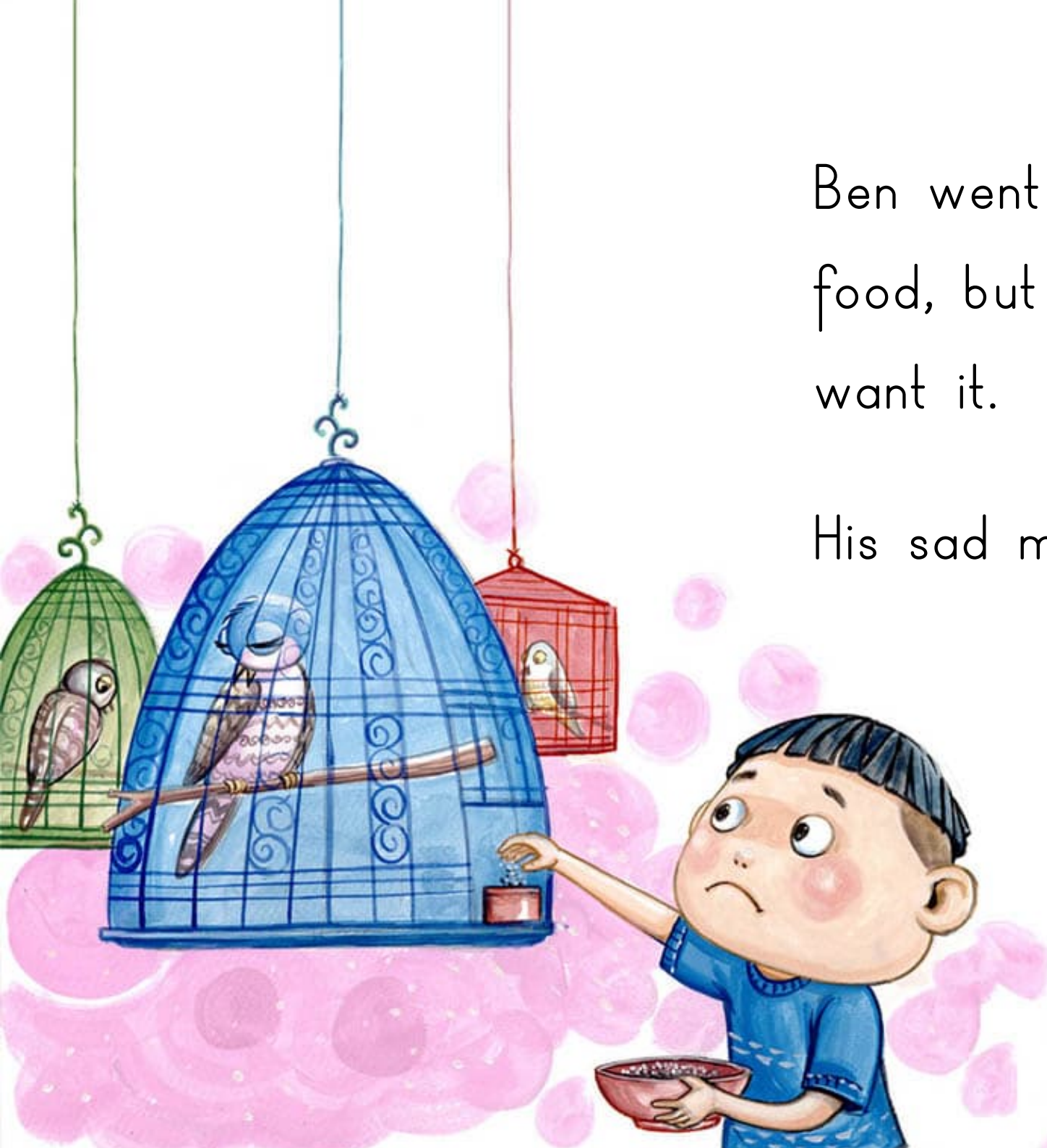
One day, Ben saw that his new birds did not want to sing.

out, and then more.



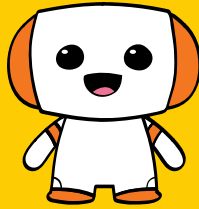
All the birds flew up in the sky, up and free. They sang once more.
