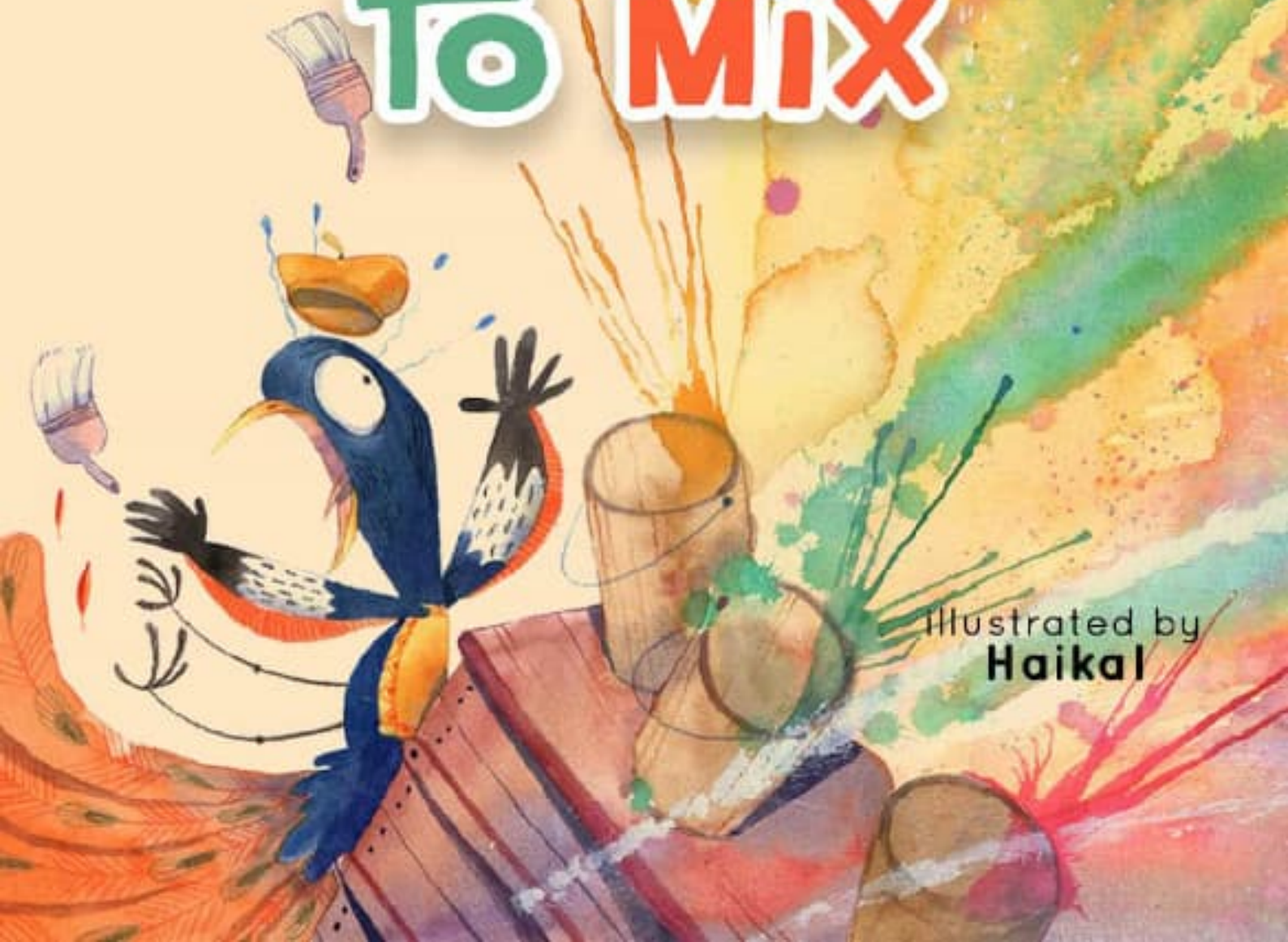


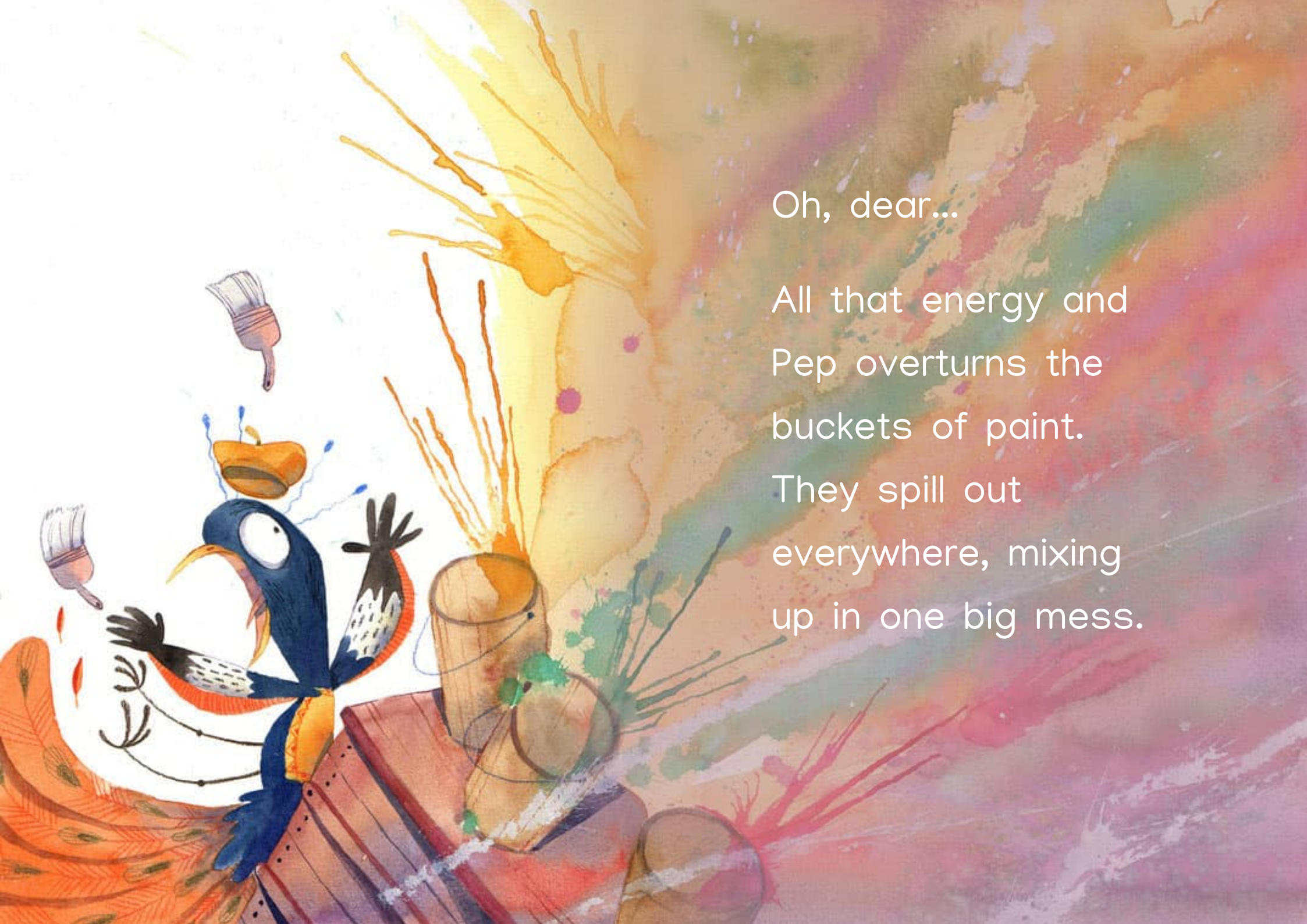
Pep Likes to Mix

and brown.

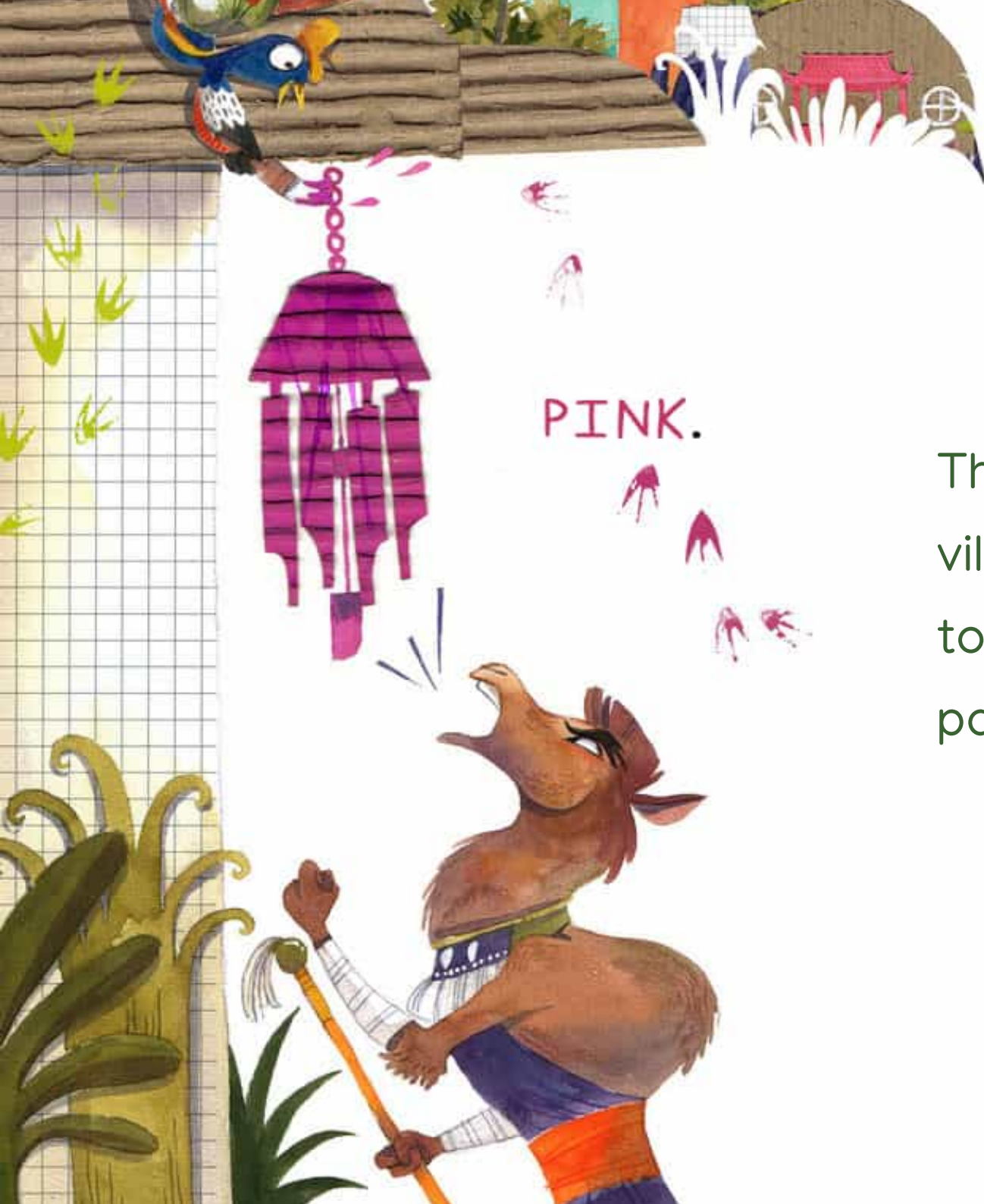


So he is convinced he can fix that. So he goes to work creating a red hut here...
