We want to catch a dragonfly.



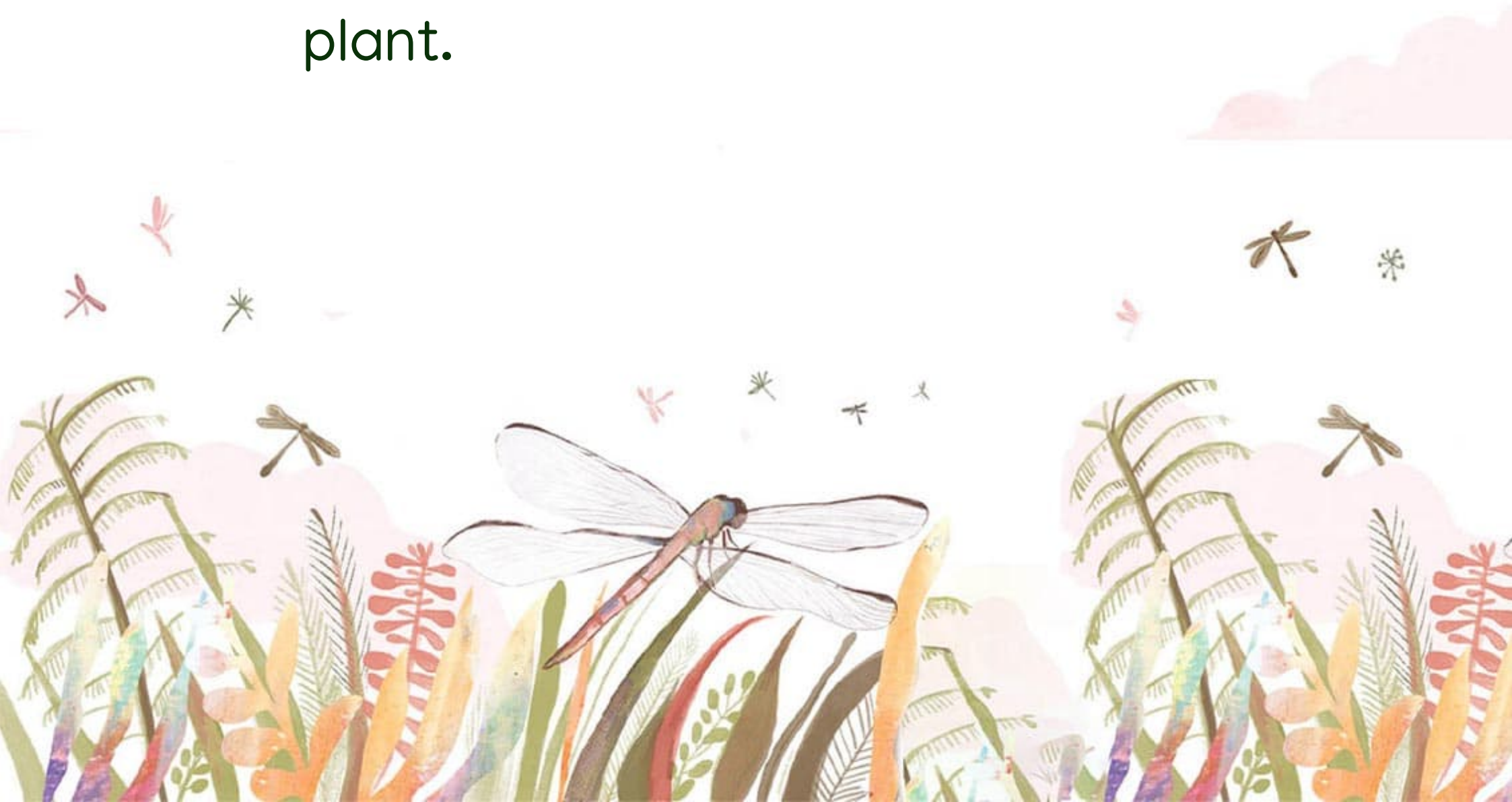
We have a brisk walk
