those fish?

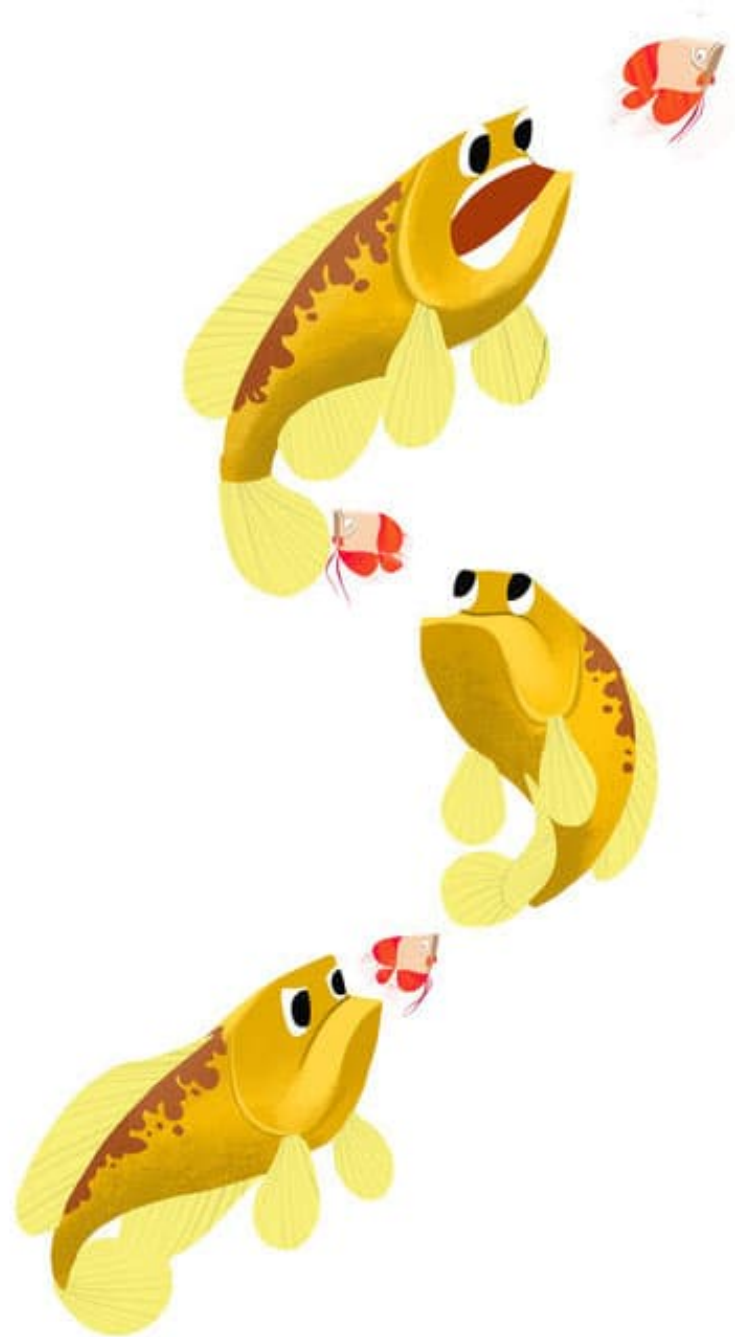




But the big rock

have it.



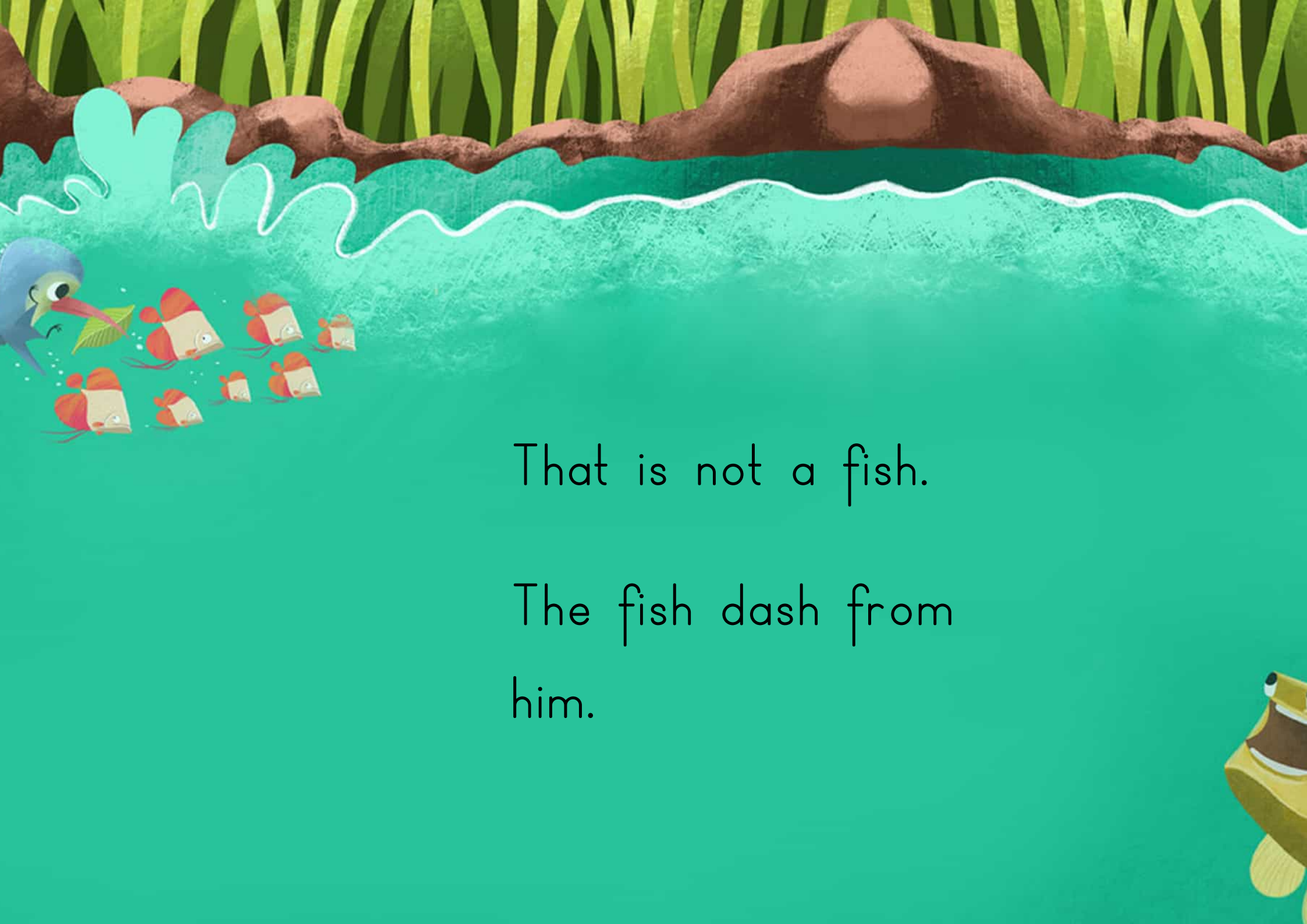
Kingfisher is in a big

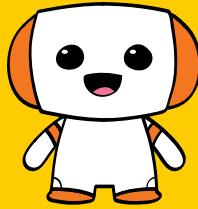
Kingfisher is up.
