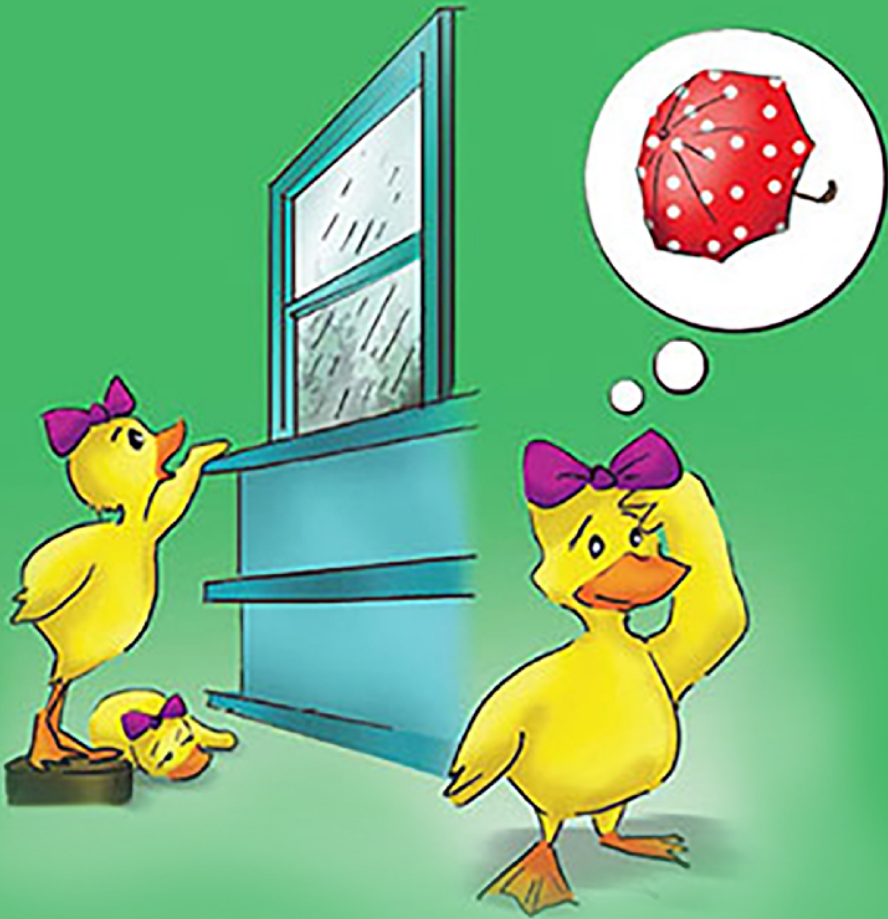

Next she sees a mouse.

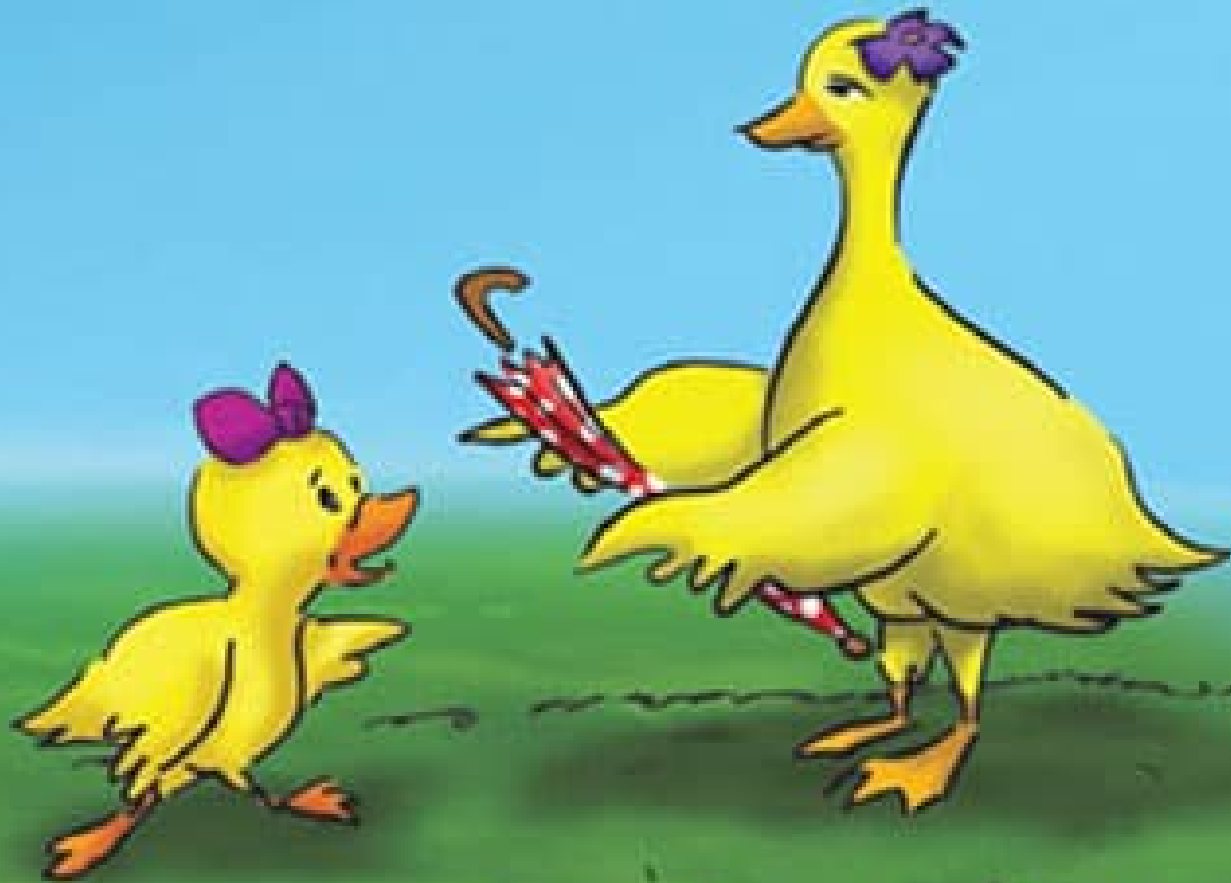
He has drawn a can over
him as an umbrella.

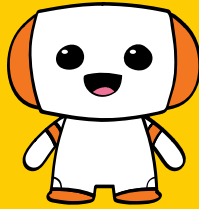
That will not do.
