think quick.

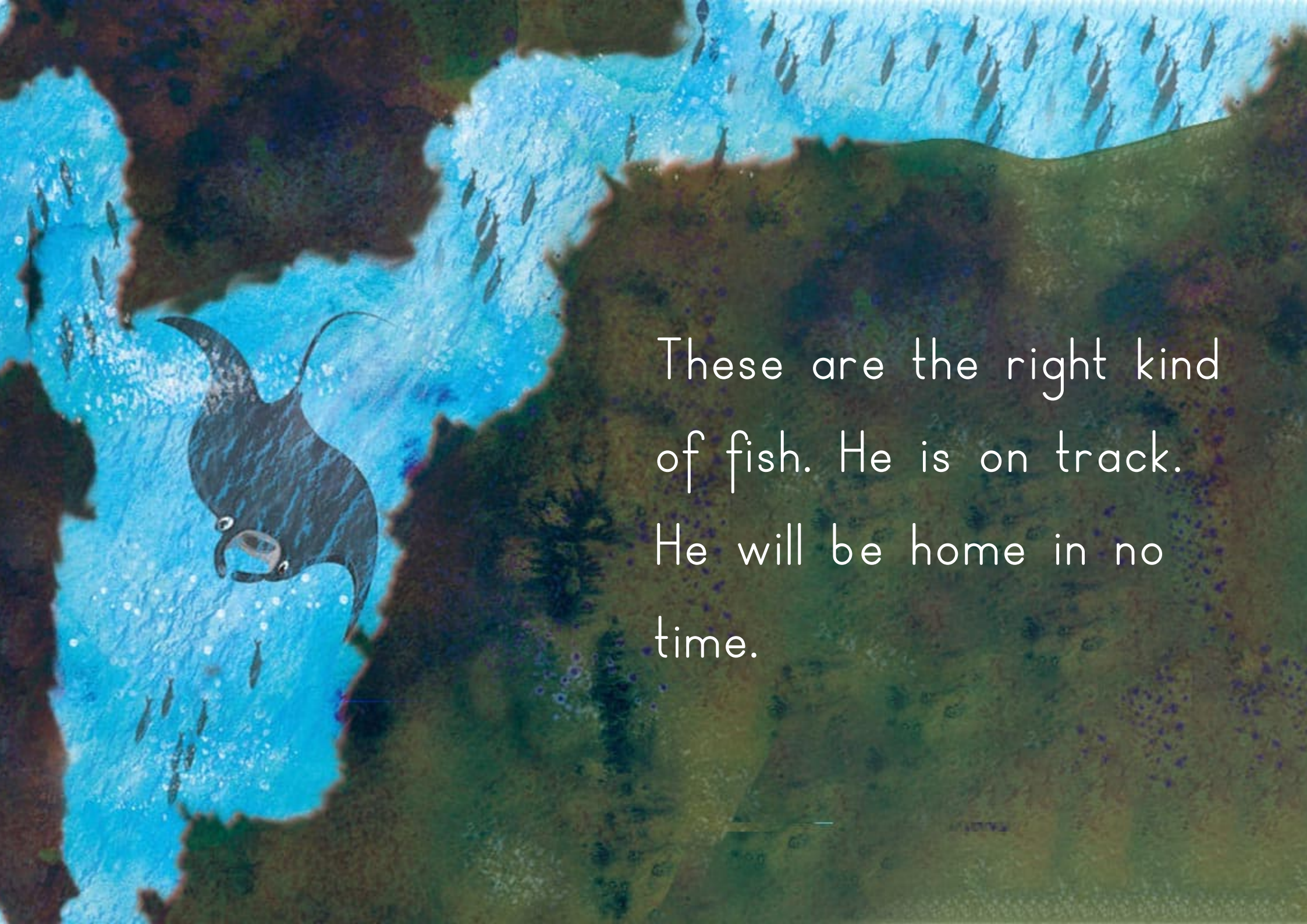


He goes deep

hurt.



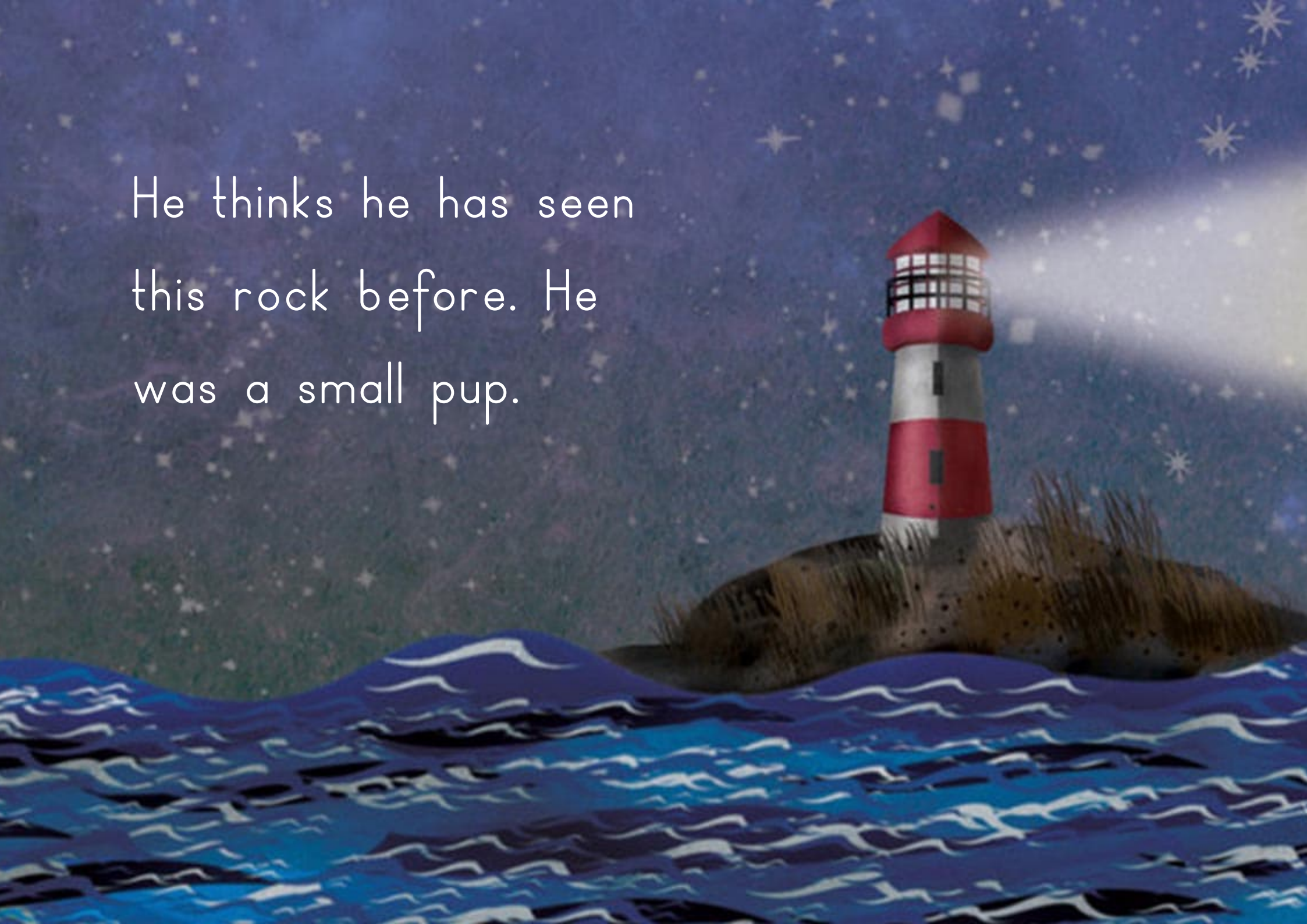


These are the right kind
