It is made of cloth.

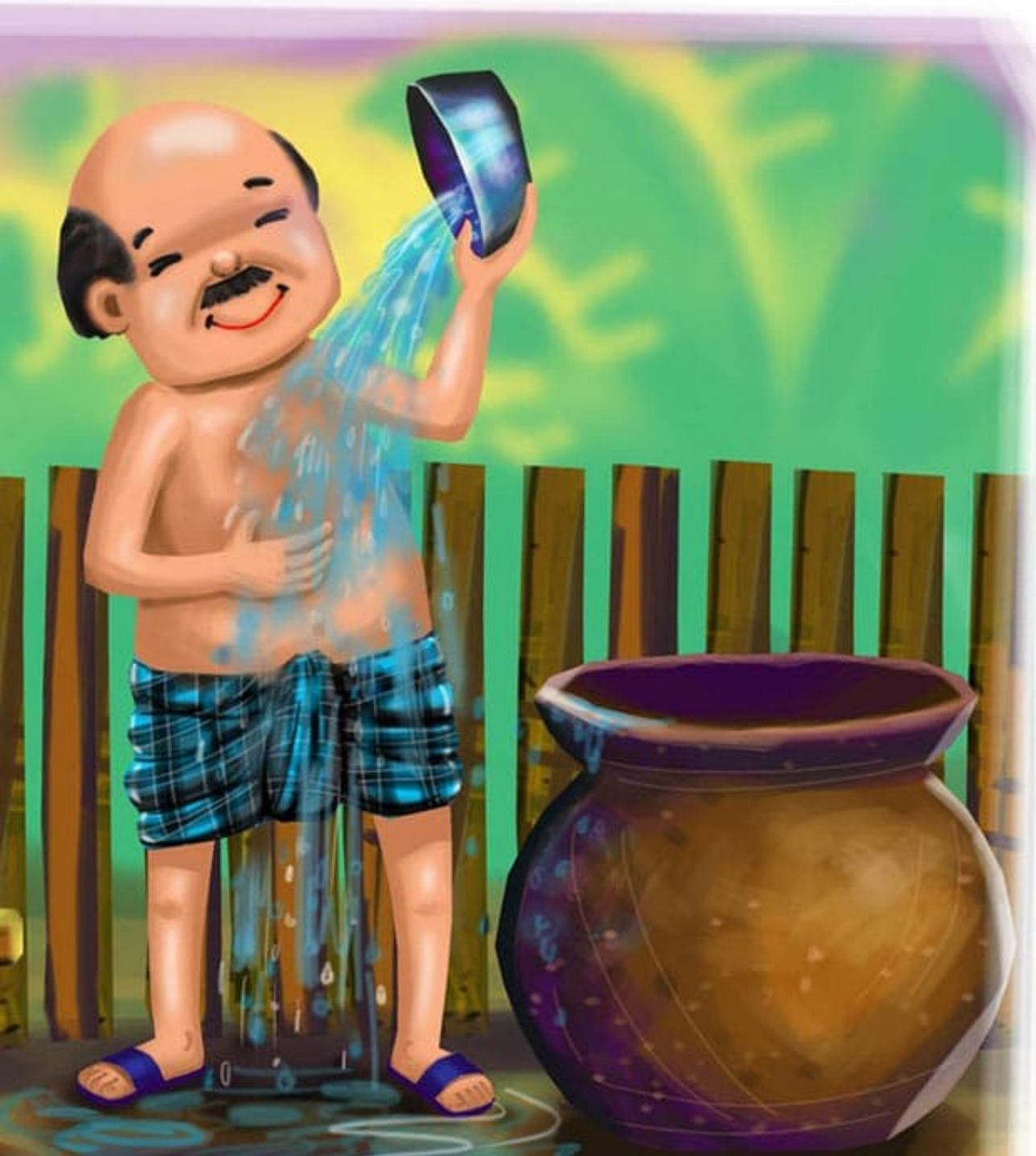






It is a nice towel.
