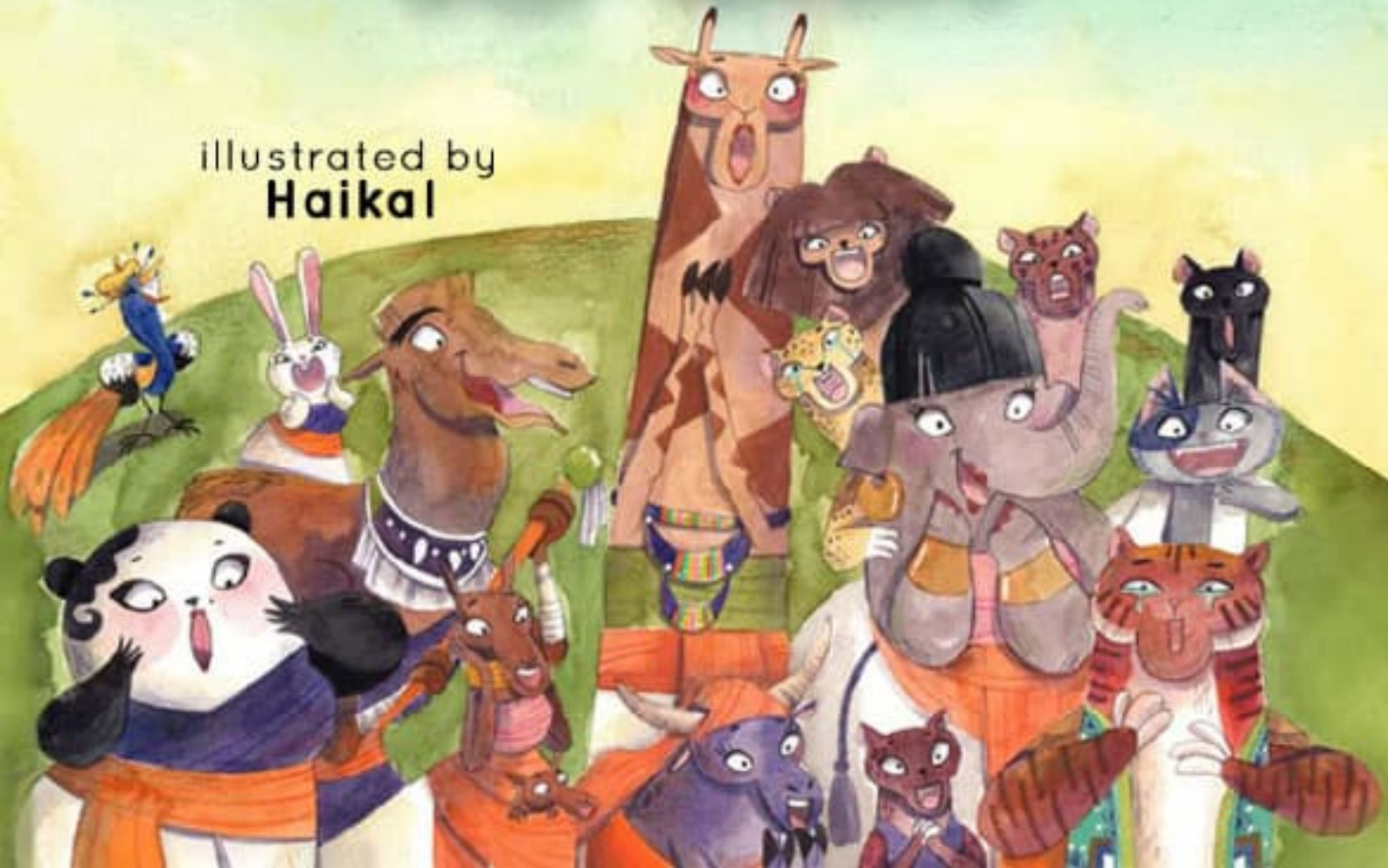


# Pep Likes to Mix

So, he starts to fix that.

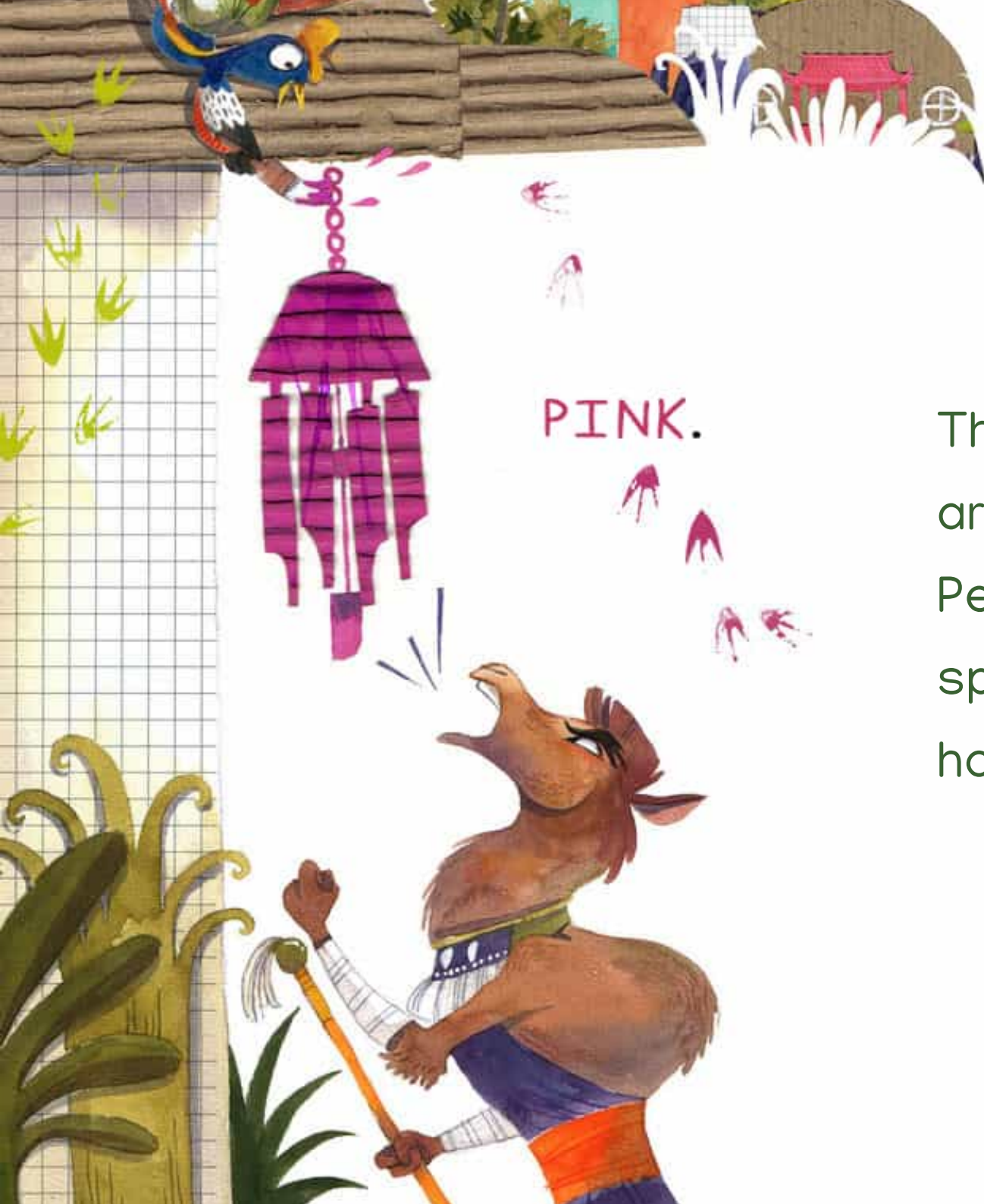
A red hut here!

prints up the path.

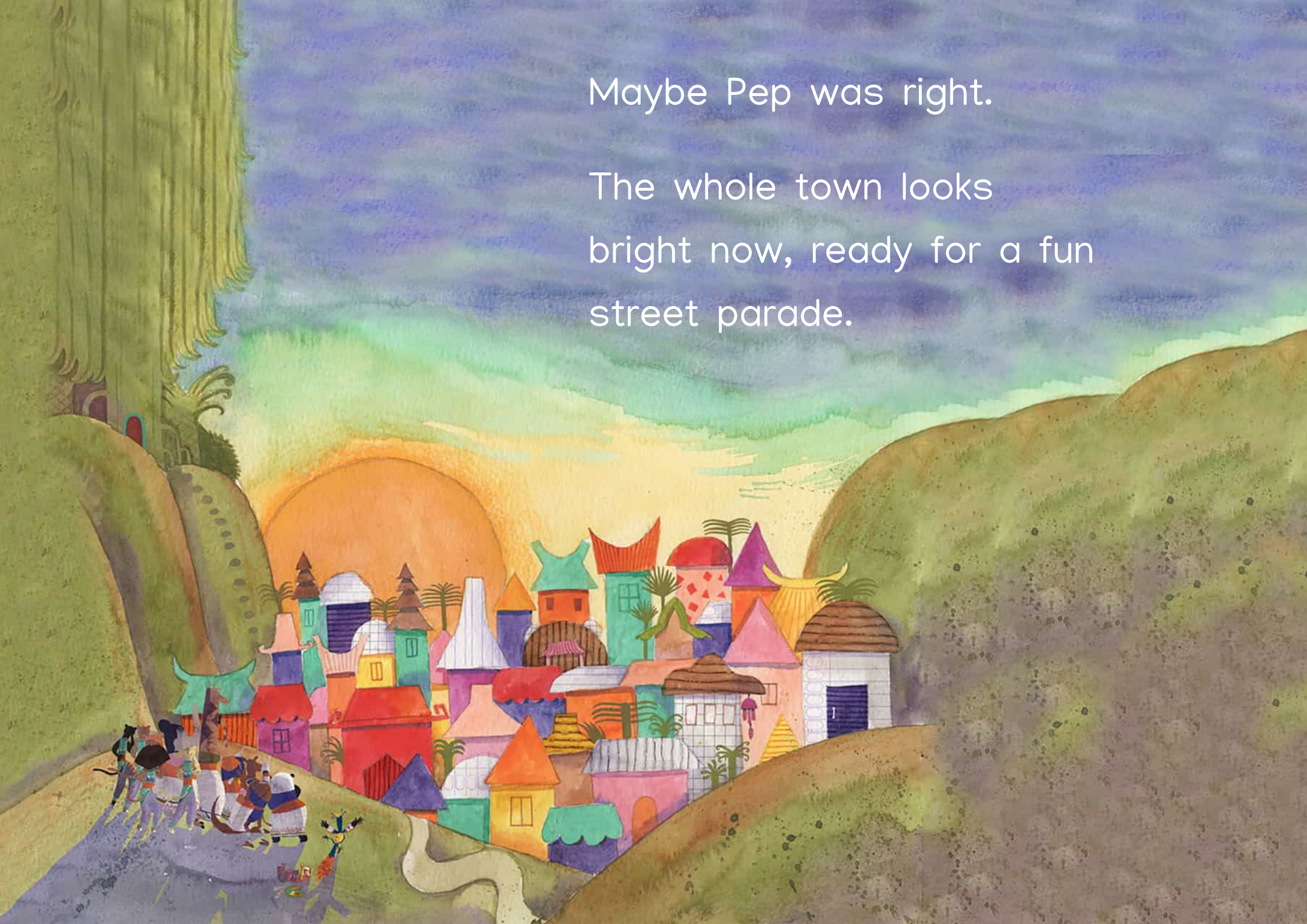


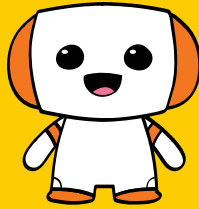
When his friends get to the top, Pep tells them to turn around and look back at the town.
