

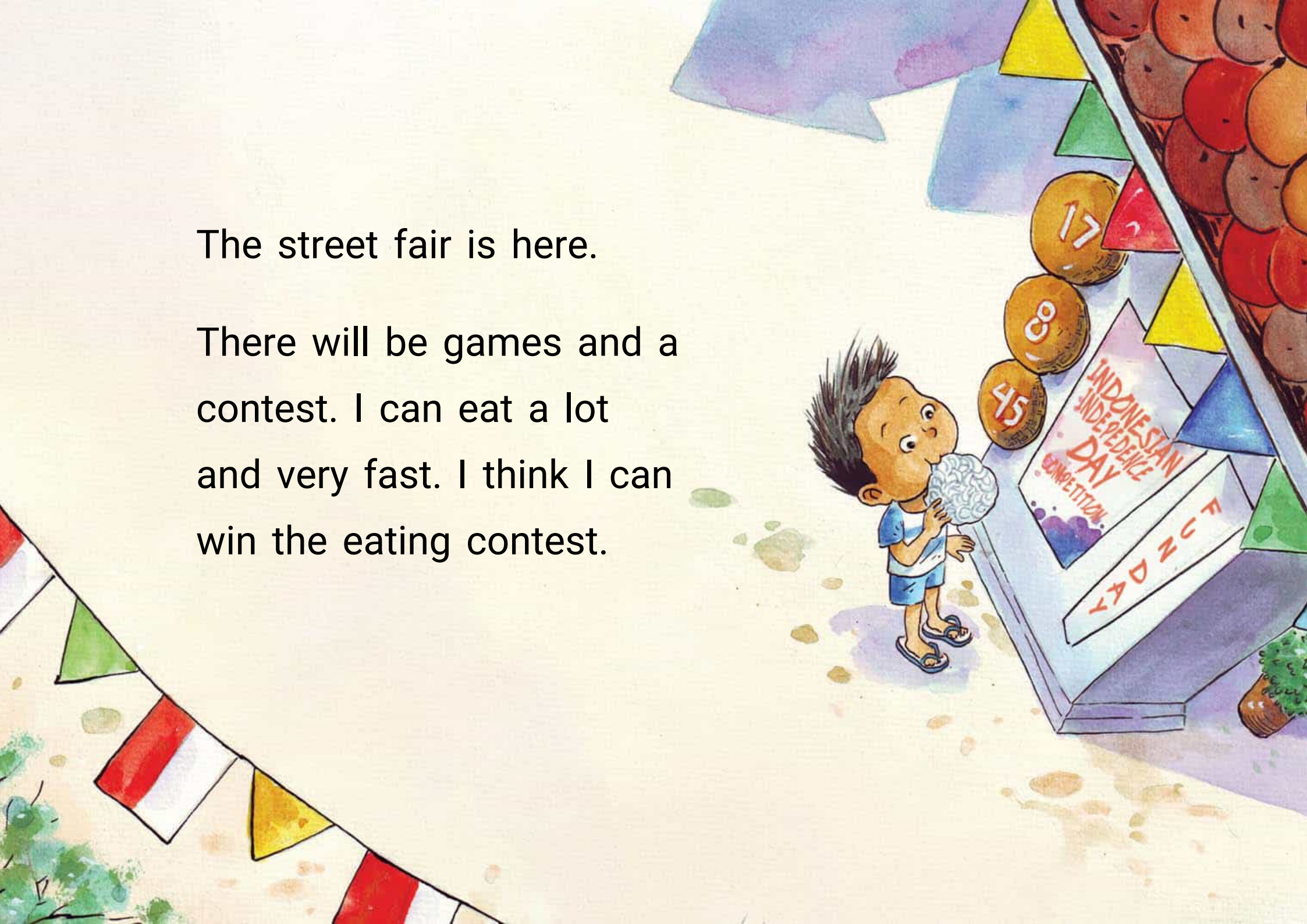

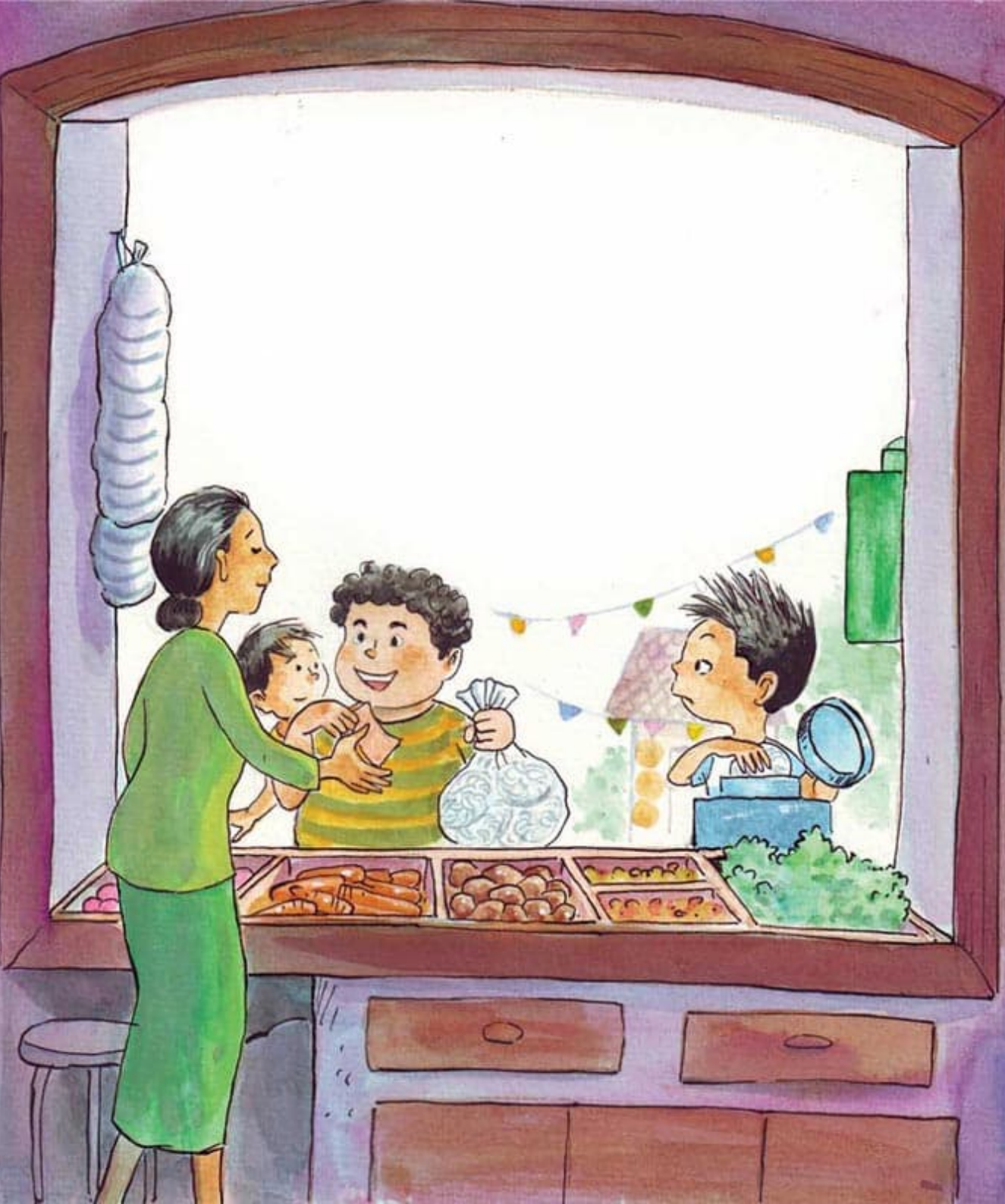

There will be games and a contest. I can eat a lot and very fast. I think I can win the eating contest.





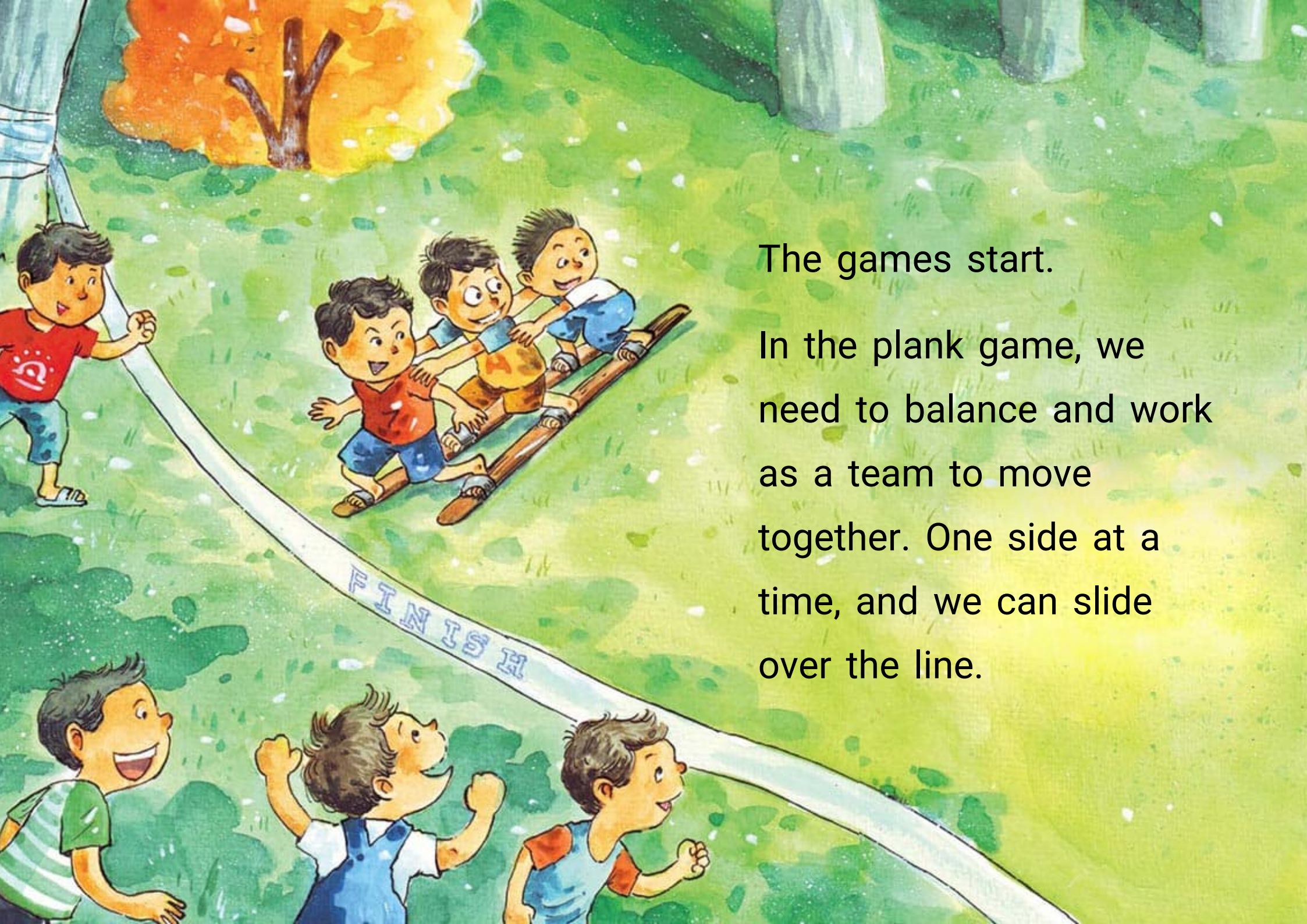
Tim says he wants to

Then, in the sack race, the other kids in my team hop quickly over the finish line. But I still want to practice, and I fall.



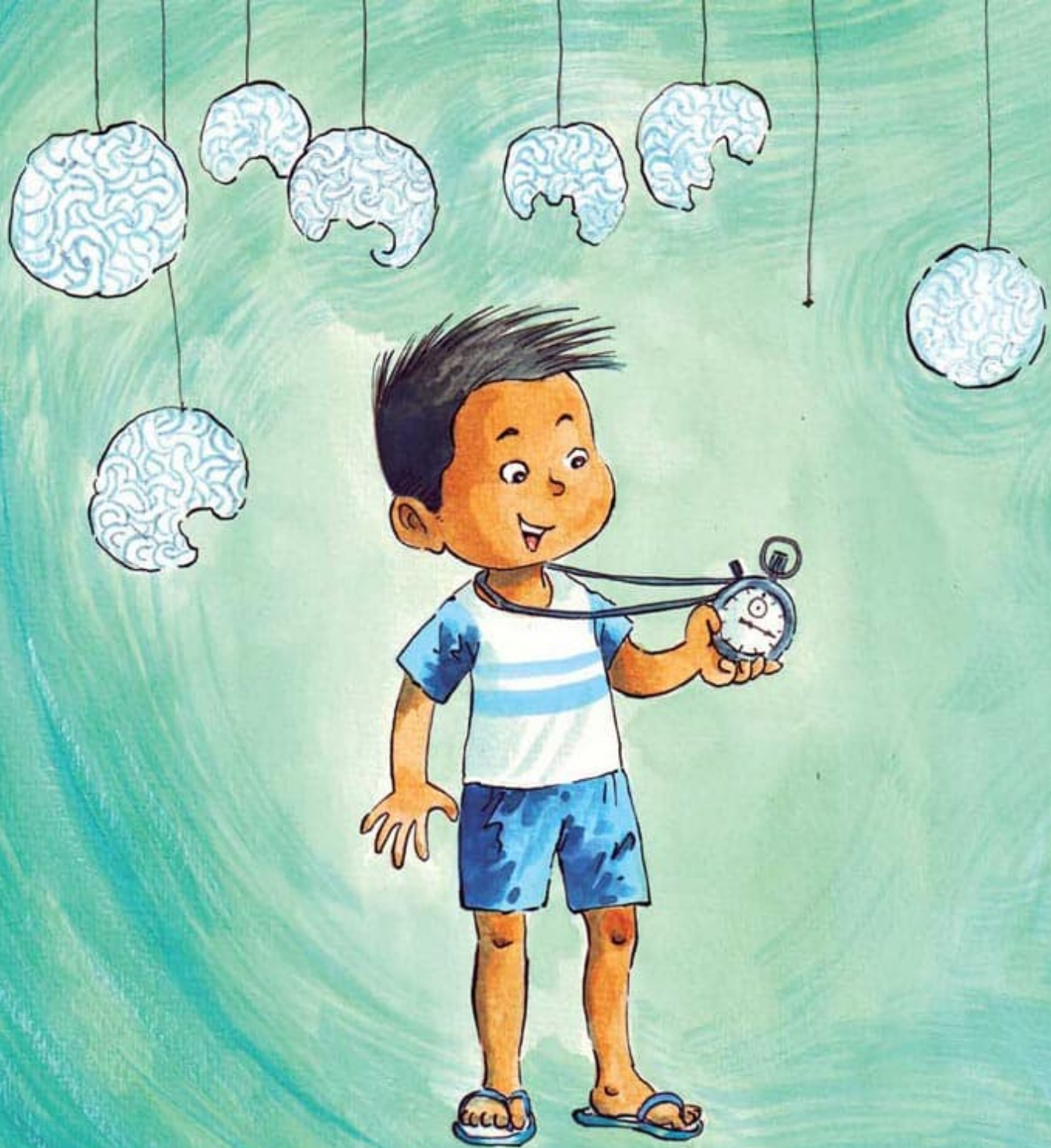
The next game is the balloon burst game. We put out heads together and try to make it pop. But my head is not in the game.

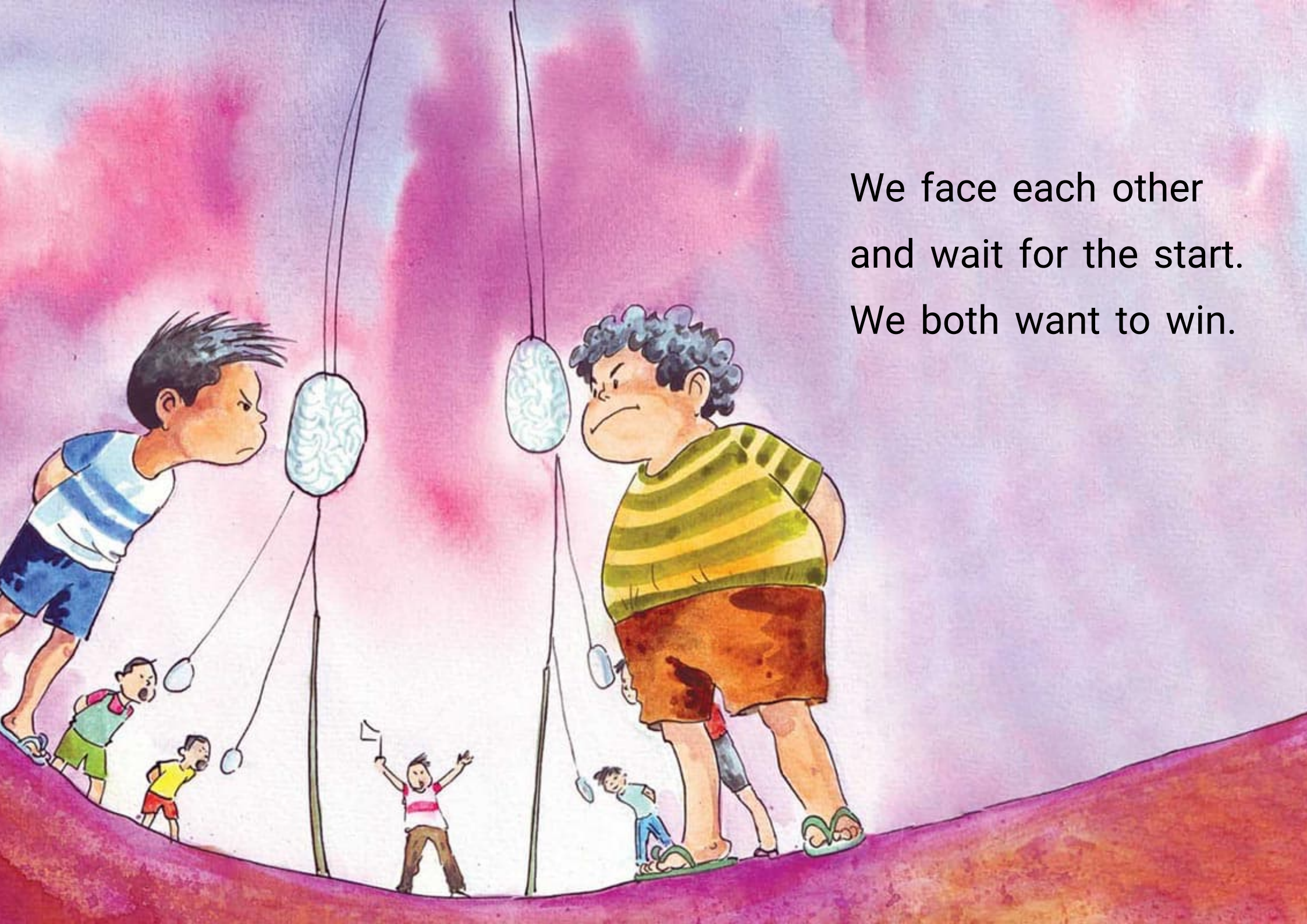
