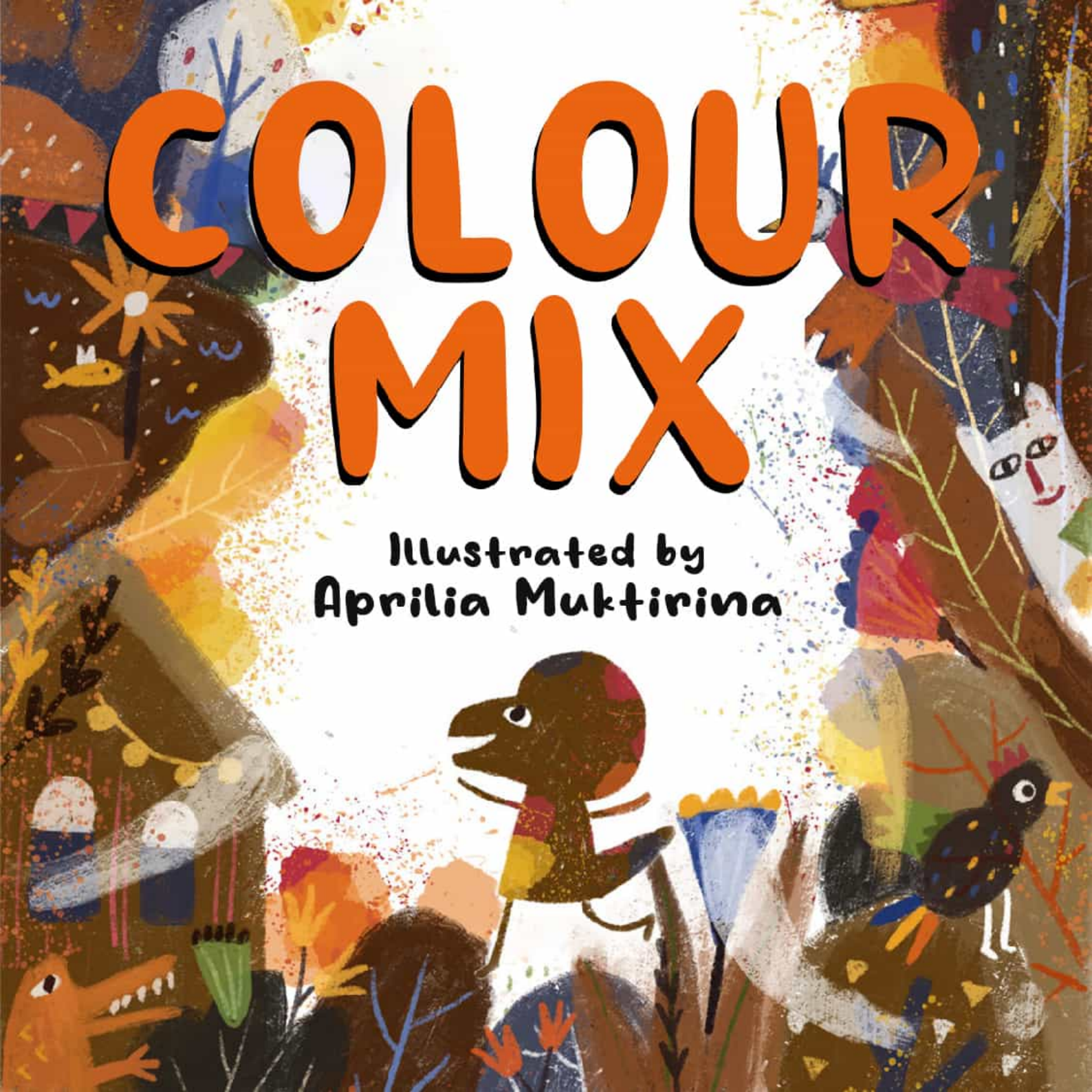


COLOUR MIX

Just three colours can make a whole lot more. They are called the primary colours. Red, blue, and yellow are primary.



Red is a strong,
powerful colour. We call
it a hot colour. Think of
hot, red things like lava.

Yellow is a warm colour,
too. It is more moderate.
Think of warm things like

It's a great shade of purple!

When there is more red, it's a warm purple. When there is more blue, it's a cool purple.

a party, and you create...

Green!

It's usually a cool colour.

But add a lot of yellow to
warm it up.



And there you have it!

Mix the primary pairs together, and you get secondary colours.

So, what happens when you mix all three at once?
