'Oh! I need to find the king!' he says.

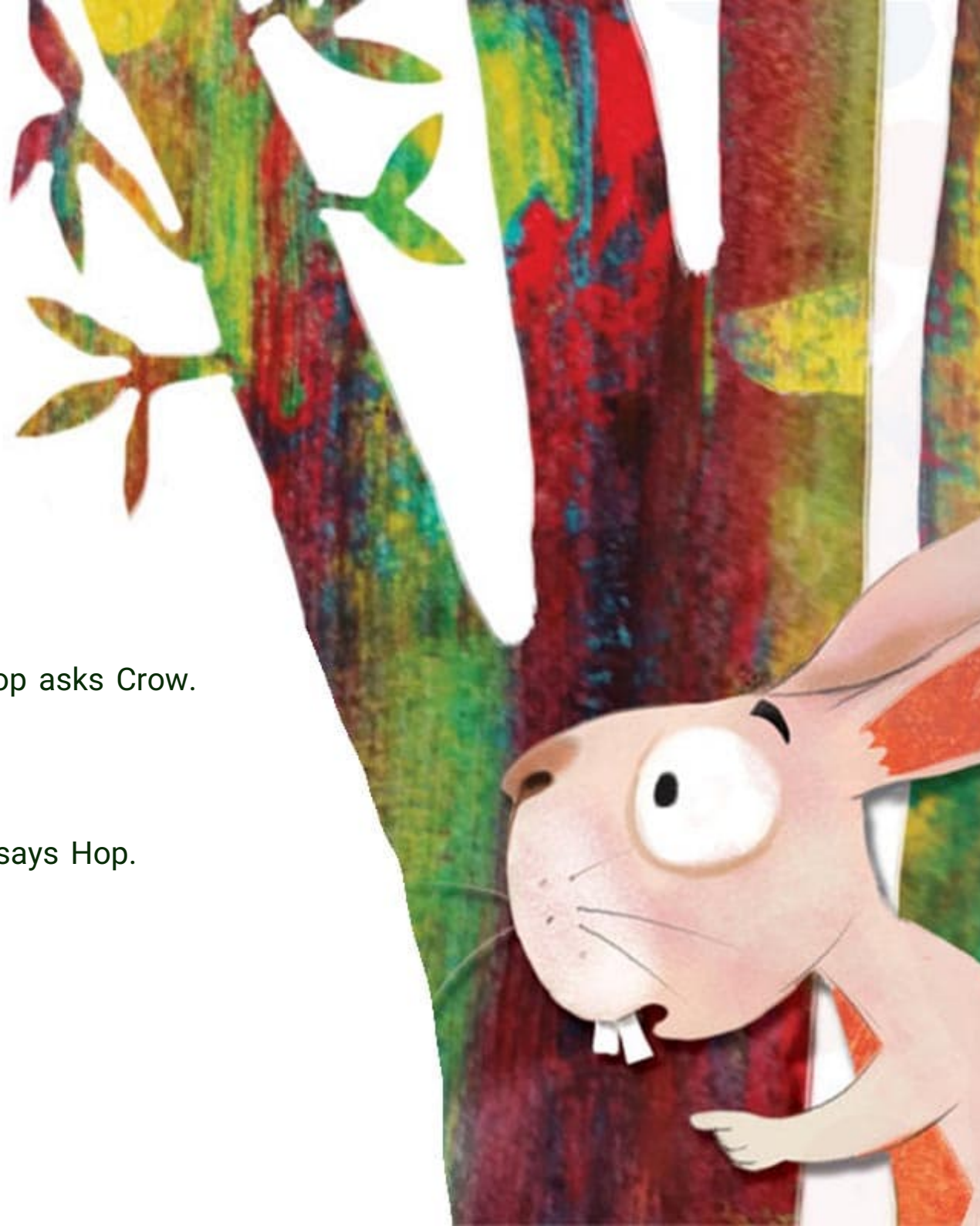




'Where is the king?' Hop asks Crow.
