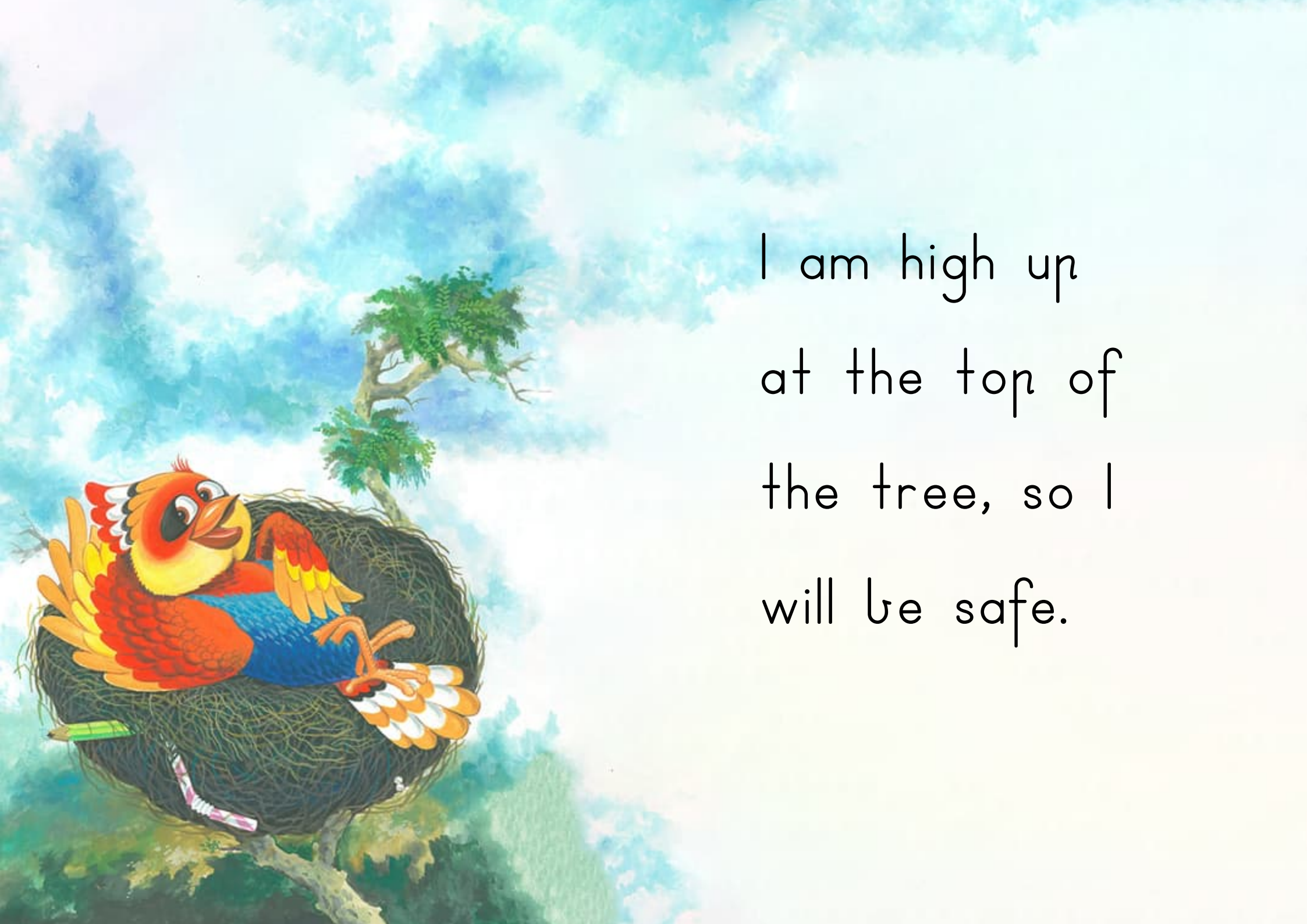

A dog in the sky?





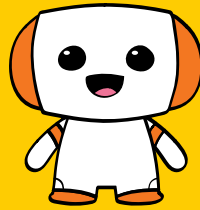
I see lots and
