OW	ow as in cow	how, now, crown, plow
	ow as in low	grow, snow, show
AI AY	ai/ay makes /a/	drain, chain, mail, praise, day, tray, stay
AW/AU	aw/au makes /or/	paw, claw, straw, haul, launch, sauce
IGH	igh (long spelling for /i/)	high, thigh, light, flight, sigh, bright
IE	ie as in grief	thief, brief, piece, shriek, pie, fried, shies, tried, spied
	ie as in tie	
EW	ew makes /u/	few, drew, flew, scew, chew, new
OI/OY	oi/oy makes /oy/	toil, coin, point, groin, boy, ploy, toy
OA	oa makes /o/	boat, goal, moan, roast, oak

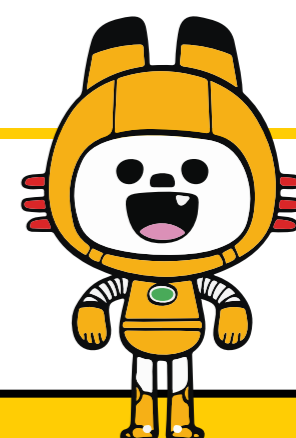

- Common Syllable Types

Level	Phonograms and skills	Examples
S1	compound words	whiteboard, daydream, airport, brainwash, driveway, password
ES	es plurals	boxes, riches, dresses, bushes, watches
S2	word + suffix (eg: ful, ment, sion)	stressful, musical, active, drainage, friendship, homeless, slowly
S3	open syllable (multisyllable)	open, begin, music, relax, siren, robot
S4	vc/cv syllable division	rabbit, blanket, mister, error, mistake, costume, traffic, sunset
S5	prefix = word (eg: re, un, in, non)	return, undone, insert, nonstop, dislike, redo
S6	stable final syllable le	stable, bottle, riddle, couple, angle
	stable final syllable al	final, total, signal, journal
	stable final syllable el	gravel, angel, camel, cancel, travel
	stable final syllable il	pencil, devil, fossil, civil, stencil
S7	v/v syllable division	lion, diet, create, giant, neon, fluid, science, area

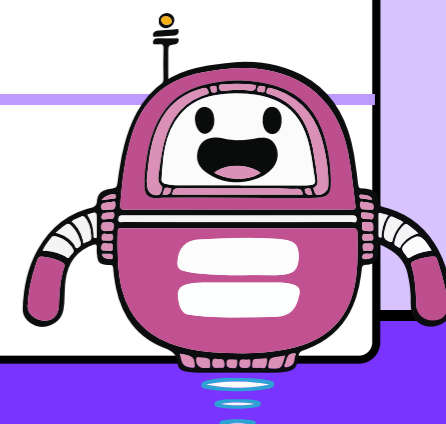

S8	3+ consonants	television, family, forgetful, caterpillar, afternoon, congratulations
S9	ci words (sh sound)	special, social, ancient
	si words (sh sound)	vision, sessions, russian, persian, siege, mission, decision
	ti words (sh sound)	patient, potential, production, traditional, christian, question
S10	all other soft c	city, cent, ice, fence, face, rice, lace, cycle, cement
KN	kn	know, knife, kneel, knob, knock, knuckle,
EI	ei	ceiling, being, veil, leisure, either, weird
OUGH	ough	tough, rough, enough, bought, plough
SI	s makes /zh/ sound	asian, measure, closure, treasury, casual
UI	ui	fluid, fruit, juice, bruise, suitcase
PH	ph	phone, photo, dolphin, elephant, orphan, pheasant

WR	wr	write, wreck, wren, wry, wrung
EIGH	eigh	eight, sleigh, freight, neighbour, weight
AUGH	augh	laugh, daughter, caught, naughty, taught, slaughter
GN	gn	gnome, deigned, gnome, reign, sign, gnash, lasagna
XI	xi (generally xion)	flexion, connexion, complexion, axion, taxi
G	soft g	village, magic, gentle, gym, fragile
