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Level	Phonograms and skills	Examples
S1	compound words	whiteboard, daydream, airport, brainwash, driveway, password
ES	es plurals	boxes, riches, dresses, bushes, watches
S2	word + suffix (eg: ful, ment sion)	stressful, musical, active, drainage, friendship, homeless, slowly
S3	open syllable (multisyllable)	open, begin, music, relax, siren, robot
S4	vc/cv syllable division	rabbit, blanket, mister, error, mistake, costume, traffic, sunset
S5	<pre>prefix = word (eg: re, un, in, non)</pre>	return, undone, insert, nonstop, dislike, redo
	stable final syllable le	stable, bottle, riddle, couple, angle
	stable final syllable <mark>al</mark>	final, total, signal, journal
S6	stable final syllable el	gravel, angel, camel, cancel, travel
	stable final syllable il	pencil, devil, fossil, civil, stencil
S7	v/v syllable division	lion, diet, create, giant, neon, fluid, science, area






