Life Cycle of a Plant



Plants start as tiny seeds. First, the seed is planted in the soil. Water and sunshine help the seed grow. Soon, roots come out of the seed and go into the ground. Then, a small stem and green leaves grow up above the soil. The plant gets bigger and flowers may appear. Flowers make new seeds, so the life cycle can start again.
