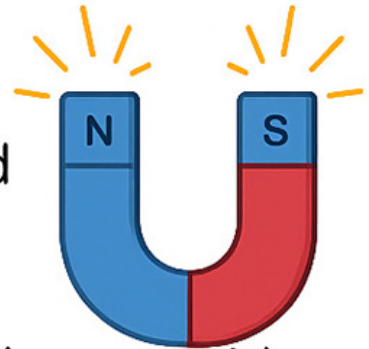

Magnetism
