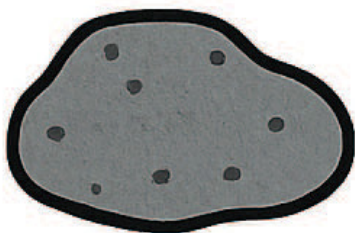


States of Matter
